DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of Robertson beginning on the 16th day February, 2021 has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from wide spread extreme cold and winter weather conditions. The result of rolling power outages and associated water shortages have also lead to widespread property damage and dangerous conditions for Robertson County residents.

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Robertson County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF ROBERTSON COUNTY:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the County of Robertson.
2. That the County's inter-jurisdictional Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
3. That this State of Disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days of the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioners Court of the County of Robertson, Texas.
4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
