

Regular Meeting of the Bremond City Council  
City of Bremond  
April 16, 2026

The regular meeting of the Bremond City Council was held in the City Hall at 6:30p.m., Thursday April 17, 2025, with the following present: Mayor Wilganowski; Councilmember's, Boudreaux, Mikolajewski, Burnett, Cook, City Secretary Zan, Chief Cook, Public Works Director Kloss, Jerry Wayne Hadley II, Allison Hadley, Ann Soto and Kie Muzyka.

1. Mayor Wilganowski called the meeting to order at 6:30p.m.
2. Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Public comments on non-agenda items- No one spoke during the allotted time.
4. Public comments on agenda items- No one spoke during the allotted time.
5. Councilmember Mikolajewski made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 19, 2026, Regular City Council Meeting. Second, by Councilmember Cook. Vote unan.
6. Payment of current City bills- Councilmember Boudreaux made a motion to approve payment of the current city bills totaling \$63,800.13 dollars. Second by Councilmember Cook. Vote unan.
7. Tax A/C Report-Councilmember Cook made a motion to approve the Tax Report for February 2026. March 2026 No report. Second by Councilmember Mikolajewski. Vote unan.
8. Burning within the City Limits. Discussion only no action taken.
9. Water Dept.-Public- James and Derrick provided a written report.
  - A. *Consider, Discuss, and Authorize the City of BREMOND to solicit Requests for Proposals (RFP's) for grant administrative services and Requests for Qualifications (RFQ's) for engineering services for the Water Supply and Infrastructure Grant program administered by the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB). Discussion Only.*
10. Utility Clerk Report- No report.
11. Municipal Court Report- Court Clerk Solley provided a written report.
12. Police Dept. – Chief Cook presented a written report.
13. Fire Dept. Report- Jerry Wayne Hadley II addressed the council letting them know Ryan Haynie stepped down as the Fire Chief and that he is the new Fire Chief, Cody Little Assistant Fire Chief and Chris Wills is the captain. Jerry asks the council about considering applying for another Fast Grant and asks if the city has the title of the 1996 fire truck. Council said that since the ESD owned the vehicles the if the ESD gave the match to the City of Bremond then they would consider applying for the Fast Grant on behalf of the BVFD. Jerry told the council the Emergency Service District has told them Franklin needs a fire truck so the 1996 truck will be given to the Franklin Fire Dept. Jerry updated the council that since the ESD pays for maintenance, insurance and everything for the vehicles that the ESD owns the vehicles. Council told Jerry we would look into the title for the vehicle. Jerry then updated the Council on their upcoming annual crawfish boil April 25, 2026.
14. Councilmember Boudreaux made a motion to approve changing City of Bremond South Star Checking Accounts General Fund, Type-A, Type-B, Building Security, Technology Fund, Consolidated Building Security/Technology Fund, Opioid Abate Trust, Police Dept. to interest bearing accounts. Second by councilmember Mikolajewski. Vote unan.
