

Regular Meeting of the Bremond City Council

July 18, 2019

The regular meeting of the Bremond City Council was held in the City Hall at 6:30pm, Thursday July 18, 2019 with the following present: Mayor Swick; Councilmember's Mikolajewski, Kujawa. Wilganowski, Boudreaux, City Secretary Zan, Office Jimenez, Public Works Kloss, Kie Muzyka, Donald and Neva Allman

1. Mayor Swick called the meeting to order at 6:30p.m.
2. Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Visitors- Mr. Muzyka addressed the Council asking if the meetings of the Type-B Corporation are posted publicly.
4. Councilmember Wilganowski made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 20, 2019 Regular Council meeting. Seconded by Councilmember Kujawa. Vote unan.
5. Payment of current City Bills - Councilmember Mikolajewski made a motion to approve payment of current city bills totaling \$41,812.71 dollars. Seconded by Councilmember Kujawa. Vote unan.
6. Tax A/C Report- Councilmember Wilganowski made a motion to approve the June 2019 Tax A/C Report. Seconded by Councilmember Mikolajewski. Vote unan.
7. Mayor's Monthly Report- Mayor Swick gave Council update on the 150th City of Bremond Birthday Bash scheduled for October 2019. Municipal Court Prosecutor update meeting with Attorney Mr. Lessman Thursday July 25, 2019. No action required.
8. Councilmember Mikolajewski made a motion to approve the City of Bremond audit report from Donald Allman, CPA, PC for Fiscal year ending September 30, 2018. Seconded by Councilmember Boudreaux. Vote unan
9. Water Dept. Report - Public Works Director Kloss provided a written report.
10. Utility Clerk Report- Utility Clerk Solley provided a written report.
 - a. Mayor Swick briefed the Council on some issues the City of Bremond has had regarding customers postdated checks/payment extensions. After discussion Councilmember Mikolajewski made a motion beginning September 1, 2019 payment extension will only be allowed once every six (6) months and customer will be required to come to City Hall and sign agreement for amount due plus any late fees and date payment will be expected to be paid. Seconded by Councilmember Boudreaux. Vote unan.
11. Court Clerk Report- Court Clerk Solley provided a written report.
 - a. Councilmember Wilganowski made a motion to table Municipal Court Prosecutor until Regular Council Meeting August 2019. Seconded by Councilmember Kujawa. Vote unan.
12. Chamber of Commerce- Mayor Swick gave Council update and the Chamber of Commerce made a profit of \$750.00 dollars for Polish Day 2019.

14. Police Dept. Report- Police Chief Pope provided a written report.

15. Councilmember Boudreaux made a motion to approve Type-B funding proposal from J&D Bar-B-Que for \$3974.97 dollars. Seconded by Councilmember Wilganowski. Vote unan.
16. Travel Trailer Park 316 S. Market Street-Councilmember Mikolajewski made a motion to table until City Attorney has time to review Ordinance. Seconded by Councilmember Wilganowski. Vote unan.
17. Ordinance No. 3-93- Councilmember Boudreaux made a motion to table. Seconded by Councilmember Mikolajewski. Vote unan.
18. City Street Renovations- Councilmember Mikolajewski made a motion to have Mayor Swick check with Knife River that is doing a TXDOT project on State Hwy 46 and if they have a sweeper and would remove the street material on West Hunt Street. Seconded by Councilmember Boudreaux. Vote unan.
