The regular meeting of the Bremond City Council was held in the City Hall at 6:30pm, Thursday March 17, 2022, with the following present: Mayor Swick; Councilmember's Mikolajewski, Wilganowski, Burnett, Boudreaux, City Secretary Zan, Police Chief Pope and Kie Muzyka.

1. Mayor Swick called the meeting to order at 6:30p.m.

Councilmember Burnett made a motion to approve City of Bremond early voting will be Monday April 25, 2022 - Friday April 29, 2022, 8am-5pm; Monday May 2, 2022, and Tuesday May 3, 2022, 8am-5pm, BREMOND CITY HALL, 201 SOUTH DALLAS ST. BREMOND, TEXAS 76629, and Election Day May 7, 2022, from 7am-7pm at JP 4 OFFICE, LOCATED AT 113 E. JACK ST. BREMOND, TEXAS 76629. Seconded by Councilmember Mikolajewski. Vote unan.
