

Regular Meeting of the Bremond City Council

The regular meeting of the Bremond City Council was held in City Hall at 6:30pm, Thursday September 15, 2022, with the following present: Mayor Swick; Councilmember's Mikolajewski, Boudreaux, Kujawa, Wilganowski, City Secretary Zan, Sergeant Cook, Joshua Gipson, John McElfish and Kie Muzyka.

1. Mayor Swick called the meeting to order at 6:31p.m.

5. Councilmember Kujawa made a motion to approve the minutes Regular Council Meeting August 18, 2022. Seconded by Councilmember Boudreaux. Vote Unan.

Councilmember Kujawa made a motion to declining AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF, **Bremond** TEXAS, (or “City”) declining to approve the change in rates requested in Entergy Texas, Inc.’s (“ETP” or “Company”) Statement of Intent filed with the city on **September 15, 2022**, AND FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS ORDINANCE WAS CONSIDERED WAS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH TEXAS LAW. Seconded by Councilmember Mikolajewski. Vote unan.
