

Regular Meeting of the Bremond City Council
City of Bremond
March 20, 2025

The regular meeting of the Bremond City Council was held in the City Hall at 6:30pm, Thursday March 20, 2025, with the following present: Mayor Wilganowski; Councilmember's Mikolajewski, Cook, Burnett, Boudreaux, Kujawa, City Secretary Zan, and Police Chief Pope, Public Works Director Kloss, Sergeant Cook and Kie Muzyka.

1. Mayor Wilganowski called the meeting to order at 6:30p.m.
2. Councilmember Burnett made a motion to appoint Heather Cook City Council Place 1. Second by Councilmember Boudreaux. Vote unan.
3. City Secretary Zan administered the Statement of Office to Councilmember Cook.
4. City Secretary Zan administered the Oath of Office to Councilmember Cook.
5. Pledge of Allegiance.
6. Public Comments on Non- Agenda Items- No one spoke during the time allotted for visitors to speak.

11. Mr. Muzyka addressed the Council about the Chamber of Commerce painting a mural on the side of the Old Ben Franklin building. He said he has been in contact with 3 artists about painting the mural and it cost around \$25,000.00 dollars. Muzyka asked the Council for permission to remove the plants and tree behind the Falls Community Clinic building that's on City property. Type-A and Type-B committee members need to become more proactive in the community.
12. Water Dept. Report- James, David and Derrick presented a written report.
 - A. Councilmember Mikolajewski made a motion to approve the purchase and financing of a new lawnmower from John Deere \$12,915.75 dollars. Second, by Councilmember Cook. Vote unan.
 - B. Councilmember Cook made a motion Mayor Wilganowski will speak with KL Groholski letting him know the City Council voted to pass the cost of closing Well #1 to Groholski Sausage Co. and the quote received from Williams Water Well was \$9600.00 dollars. Second by Councilmember Mikolajewski. Vote unan.
 - C. Public Works Director Kloss gave an update on Austin Street closure that there is a 6" PVC Water Main that was installed in 1983-1984 and runs from Sabine Street to State Hwy FM 1373. There is no action taken discussion only.
 - D. Councilmember Burnett approved Public Works Director Kloss to get Hensel Electric to trouble shoot the emergency siren. Second by Councilmember Kujawa. Vote unan.
