

Regular Meeting of the Bremond City Council

March 19, 2026

The regular meeting of the Bremond City Council was held in the City Hall at 6:30pm, Thursday March 19, 2026, with the following present: Mayor Wilganowski; Councilmember's Mikolajewski, Cook, Burnett, Boudreaux, Kujawa, City Secretary Zan, and Police Chief Cook, Public Works Director Kloss, Dwayne Wachel, Jennifer Hunt, Michelle Bobo, Eric Jones, Matt Rekieta, John Rush, Ann Soto. and Kie Muzyka.

1. Mayor Wilganowski called the meeting to order at 6:32p.m.
2. Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Public Comments on Non- Agenda Items- Dwayne Wachel addressed the council regarding installing a fence in the right of way at 218 N. Commerce St. Ann Soto addressed the Council burning in the City Limits and require burning in a barrel not on the open ground. Kie Muzyka addressed the Council on lack of traffic on Hwy 14/Commerce St. and the new Barber Shop and restaurant.

 - B. *MIT-MOD Generator Grant- Councilmember Mikolajewski made a motion to approve splitting the generator cost with Rekieta Electrical in the amount of \$14,175.00 dollars. Second by Councilmember Boudreaux. Vote unan.*
