CAPITAL

- Mexico City, Mexico
- Currency: Mexican Peso

LANGUAGE

- Official language: Spanish
- The Mexican government recognizes 68 national languages, 63 of which are indigenous, including around 350 dialects of those languages. The large majority of the population is monolingual in Spanish.





TIME ZONE

Mexico has four standard time zones that mirror the time zones of the contiguous US. They do recognize Daylight Saving Time (with the exception of Sonora.

- Cancun area This mandatory tourist tax came into effect in 2020
- This state tax is not collected by any of the airlines, nor any resorts
- The tax is 241mxn (~ \$12) per person

- Green hope and victory
- White unity
- Red pays tribute to the heroes that fought for independence
