

Official Raffle Rules

1) By purchasing a raffle ticket, each purchaser agrees to be bound by these Official Rules and by the decisions of [Temple Sinai of Sharon](<http://temple-sinai.com>) (the "Raffle Sponsor"), which shall be binding and final as to all matters related to the raffle. The raffle is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws. The raffle is being conducted pursuant to a raffle permit issued to Raffle Sponsor by the Town of Sharon.

2) Tickets must be purchased:

A) through the website, <http://www.rav4raffle.org>, and payment has to be processed by either credit or debit card. Any credit or debit card payment that is denied shall disqualify the pending purchase and any ticket issued for such purchase will be forfeited by the purchaser and be null and void. All online ticket sales shall be via the raffle website

B) Utilizing an official paper raffle ticket paid by cash or check payable to Temple Sinai. Any check that is denied shall disqualify the pending purchase and any ticket issued for such purchase will be forfeited by the purchaser and be null and void.

All communication will be sent to the e-mail address provided by the purchaser as part of the purchase or, in some cases, by telephone or U.S. mail. Such communications shall include purchase confirmation and raffle ticket number. Purchaser is required to provide to the Raffle Sponsor and the raffle coordinators a valid, functioning e-mail address as well as a valid mailing address and telephone number in the continental U.S. The Raffle Sponsor, its agents and their respective trustees, directors, officers, and members assume no responsibility for incorrect, invalid, terminated, or non-functioning e-mail or mailing addresses or telephone numbers or lost incomplete, late, illegible, or undelivered entries or entries without complete and acceptable payment.

3) The raffle ticket price is \$100.00. Once a ticket has been purchased, it is non-refundable except in the event the raffle is cancelled in accordance with Massachusetts raffle regulations. No portion of the raffle ticket price may be deducted as a charitable contribution for federal income tax purposes. Odds of winning depend on the number of tickets sold (minimum 350 tickets | maximum 500 tickets).

4) The First Prize will be a silver 2018 Toyota RAV4 XLE, (manufacturer's suggested retail price \$30,239.00), which the Raffle Sponsor believes to be the appraised value of the prize, or \$22,500.00, payable by check. The First Prize winner is responsible for all taxes, delivery costs, registration, and dealer fees. If the winner chooses the check option, an applicable amount would be withheld from for Federal and state income taxes. The gross winnings of the raffle will be treated as ordinary income to the First Prize winner for federal and state income tax purposes and will be reported to the federal and state tax authorities at the base MSRP, unless the cash option has been chosen. The First Prize winner is responsible for income tax withholding prior to taking title to the prize. Please consult with your own tax advisor. Second Prize will be an Apple Watch Series 3. Individuals may purchase as many tickets as they wish;

however, only a maximum of 500 tickets will be sold. Participants must be at least 21 years old. The raffle is void where prohibited by law. The prizes are not redeemable for cash. If a minimum of 350 tickets is not sold, all ticket holders will receive a full refund and the raffle will not occur. All net proceeds from the raffle will be retained by the Raffle Sponsor for its operations and other activities of the Raffle Sponsor.

5) The raffle period will run from November 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017 or until at least 350 tickets are sold. The drawing will be held on January 1, 2018. Ticket purchase deadlines and drawing dates, times, and locations may be extended or changed at the Raffle Sponsor's discretion, subject to Massachusetts regulations. Each purchaser will be sent a receipt via email that will identify the purchaser's unique raffle ticket number(s). A copy of the computer receipt will be retained by the Raffle Sponsor and entered into the drawing along with all other entries. Depositing raffle tickets in the mail is a violation of federal law and could lead to criminal penalties. Persons who purchase raffle tickets may opt to give away their raffle tickets to others, but in doing so they give up any claim they might otherwise have to the prize if they surrender a winning raffle ticket. If a raffle ticket is transferred, the initial purchaser must notify the Raffle Sponsor. The Raffle Sponsor is not responsible for disputes involving transfers of raffle tickets. Purchasers of raffle tickets may not re-sell their raffle tickets to other parties, and may not knowingly give such raffle tickets away to others for the purpose of allowing those other parties to re-sell such raffle tickets. All raffle tickets which have been resold in violation of these Official Rules shall be void. All individuals who re-sell raffle tickets in violation of these Official Rules shall be ineligible to participate in the raffle or to win the prizes.

6) At the drawing, the winning raffle tickets will be chosen by picking them from a container holding all copies of computer receipts that have been thoroughly mixed. The drawing shall take place January 1, 2018 or within seven (7) days of the 350th ticket being sold, whichever is later. The winners do not need to be present at the drawing to win, and if a new date is selected, all purchasers will be notified of the new date or other changes via e-mail. The First Prize winner must satisfy Federal taxes and will have the opportunity to inspect the prize and must claim prize within thirty (30) days of notification of winning. If the First Prize winner fails to comply a new drawing will be held and all purchasers will again be notified. In this unlikely event, the aforementioned winner will forfeit his or her rights to participate in subsequent raffle and shall release and hold harmless the Raffle Sponsor, its agents and their respective trustees, directors, officers, and members from any liability.

7) The holder of the winning First Prize ticket shall be notified by telephone, e-mail, and certified U.S. mail at the address provided by the purchaser. The winning ticket numbers and names of the winners and their respective cities (but not addresses) shall also be placed on the raffle website immediately after the drawing. This information may also be publicized in other media sources.

8) The winners of the drawing shall be required to provide the Raffle Sponsor with a signed statement confirming their eligibility under these Official Rules and applicable law, proof of age, social security number, and a release confirming the Raffle Sponsor's permission to use his or her name, city, state, and likeness in media releases and other publicity.

9) Purchasers of tickets, by participating in the raffle, release the Raffle Sponsor, its agents and their respective trustees, directors, officers, and members from any and all liability, loss or claim arising out of any raffle prize, expressly waive any such claim and agree that the liability, if any, of the Raffle Sponsor, its agents and their respective trustees, directors, officers, and members shall be limited to the raffle ticket price paid. The courts of Norfolk County, Massachusetts, shall have exclusive jurisdiction and venue for any dispute concerning the raffle.

10) In the event less than 350 tickets are sold during the raffle sales duration, a decision by the Raffle Sponsor will be made whether to hold the raffle, or not. In the case the raffle is cancelled, all monies shall be returned in full via the same method used for the purchase. All cash purchases of tickets will be returned via check.

11) The raffle coordinators and their immediate family members (spouses and/or children) are prohibited from purchasing a raffle ticket.

12) The Raffle Sponsor, its agents and their respective trustees, directors, officers, and members are not responsible for: (1) entries which are stolen, lost, damaged, illegible, given away or no longer in the purchaser's possession; (2) entries that have been or may have been tampered with or re-sold in violation of these Official Rules; (3) entries or payments that are delayed, misdirected, undelivered, not fully captured, or garbled as a result of any failure or problem whatsoever with the availability, functionality, operability or use of any network, server, ISP, website, computer, telephone, cable or satellite modem or connection, hand held mobile device or any other computer equipment or connection, whether or not caused by site users, tampering, hacking, or by viruses, worms, or malfunctions affecting a network, server ISP or any equipment or programming used in or associated with the raffle; (4) any other errors of any kind, whether human, typographical, printing, mechanical, or electronic in nature, which relate to or are connected with the raffle (collectively, as described in clauses (1) through (4), "Errors"), including without limitation Errors in raffle-related materials or in the administration of the raffle, such as Errors in processing entries, identifying potential winners, determining official winners, or announcing or delivering the prize. If any portion of the raffle is compromised, in the Raffle Sponsor's sole judgment, by a virus, worm, bug, non-authorized human intervention or other causes which, in the Raffle Sponsor's sole judgment, corrupt or impair the administration, security, fairness or proper play of the raffle, or the proper submission or capture of entries (collectively, a "Compromising Event"), then the Raffle Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to suspend, modify or terminate the raffle, and to select winners from all eligible, non-suspect entries received before the known occurrence or discovery of such Compromising Event. All purchases shall be final, and no refunds or

replacements will be issued by the Raffle Sponsor. The Raffle Sponsor has sole and final decision on the admissibility of entries and the determination of the prize winners.
