Mega Psalms- Combination of 4:1-8, 10:17-18, 11:1, 17:1-2, 35:23-24, & 43:1, Psalms 5, and the Ndikhokhele Bawo)

GENERAL PURPOSE

THIS PRAYER IS FOR WHEN ALL HOPE IS LOST IN A SITUATION, MAINLY FOR COURT AND ENSURING JUSTICE

INSTRUCTION:

POUR CLEAN HOT WATER IN A CLEAR GLASS BOWL.

PART 1:

THE PRAYER IS FOR OVERALL JUSTICE TO BE SERVED BY ALL THE MOST POWERFUL PSALMS BLENDED TOGETHER. SPEAK THE PRAYER OVER THE WATER.

PART 2:

PRAY PSALMS 5 OVER THE WATER WHILE PLACING YOUR HAND IN THE WATER AND SWIRLING IT AROUND

PART 3:

SING OR SAY THE NDIKHOKHELE BAWO OVER YOUR FRONT DOOR, OR PLACE OF OFFENCE. ONCE DONE, SPRINKLE THE WATER ALL OVER THE HOME OR PLACE OF OFFENCE FOR PROTECTION.





PART 1

Mega Psalms- Combination

Answer me when I call to you,
my righteous God.
Give me relief from my distress;
have mercy on me and hear my prayer
How long will you people turn my glory into shame?
How long will you love delusions and seek false gods
Know that the Lord has set apart his faithful servant
for himself;

the Lord hears when I call to him.
Tremble and do not sin;
when you are on your beds,
search your hearts and be silent.
Offer the sacrifices of the righteous
and trust in the Lord.
Many, Lord, are asking, "Who will bring us
prosperity?"

Let the light of your face shine on us.

Fill my heart with joy
when their grain and new wine abound.
In peace I will lie down and sleep,
for you alone, Lord,
make me dwell in safety.

You, Lord, hear the desire of the afflicted; you encourage them, and you listen to their cry, defending the fatherless and the oppressed,

so that mere earthly mortals
will never again strike terror.
In the Lord I take refuge.
How then can you say to me:
"Flee like a bird to your mountain.
Hear me, Lord, my plea is just;

listen to my cry.

Hear my prayer—
it does not rise from deceitful lips.
Let my vindication come from you;
may your eyes see what is right.
Awake, and rise to my defense!
Contend for me, my God and Lord.
Vindicate me in your righteousness, Lord my God;

do not let them gloat over me.
Vindicate me, my God,
and plead my cause
against an unfaithful nation.
Rescue me from those who are
deceitful and wicked.



PART 2

Psalms 5

Give ear to my words, O Lord; consider my <u>ugroaning</u>.

2 Give attention to the sound of my cry, my <u>v</u>King and my God, for <u>w</u>to you do I pray.

3 O Lord, in <u>x</u>the morning you hear my voice;

in the morning I prepare a sacrifice for you<u>1</u> and <u>y</u>watch.

4 For you are not a God who delights in wickedness;

evil may not dwell with you.

5 The <u>z</u>boastful shall not <u>a</u>stand before your eyes;

you <u>b</u>hate all evildoers.

6 You destroy those who speak <u>c</u>lies; the Lord abhors <u>d</u>the bloodthirsty and deceitful man.

7 But I, through the abundance of your steadfast love,

will enter your house.

I will <u>e</u>bow down <u>f</u>toward your gholy temple

in the fear of you.

8 <u>h</u>Lead me, O Lord, in your righteousness

because of my enemies; imake your way straight before me.

9 For there is no truth in their mouth; their inmost self is jdestruction; <u>k</u>their throat is <u>l</u>an open grave; they <u>m</u>flatter with their tongue.

10 <u>n</u>Make them bear their guilt, O God; let them <u>o</u>fall by their own counsels; because of the abundance of their transgressions cast them out, for they have rebelled against you.

11 But let all who <u>p</u>take refuge in you \underline{q} rejoice;

let them ever sing for joy, and spread your protection over them, that those who love your name may rexult in you.

12 For you <u>s</u>bless the righteous, O Lord; you <u>t</u>cover him with favor as with <u>u</u>a shield.





PART 3

Ndikhokhele Bawo

Ndikhokhele Bawo is a traditional South African song, in Xhosa language based on Psalm 23.

Here is the the English translation:
"Guide me, O Lord, O great redeemer
through the troubles of this world
Lord, I thank you for watching over me thus
far. You are forever by my side."

This song is meant to seal in all of your prayers in one. It can be sung in place of the long prayers
