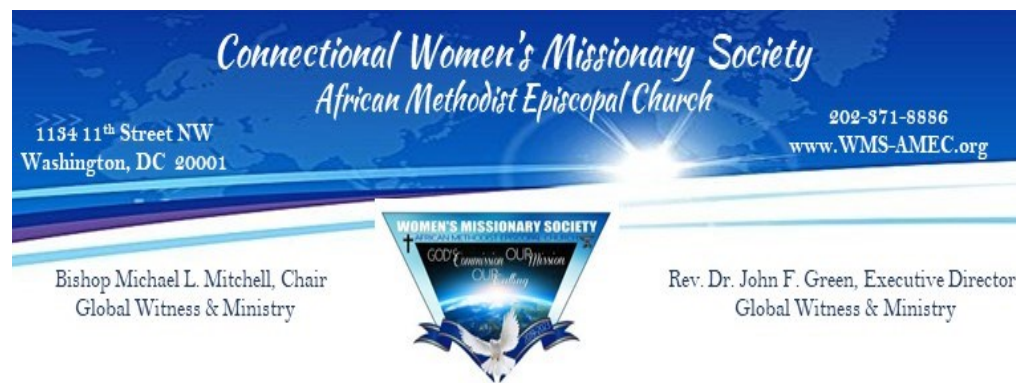

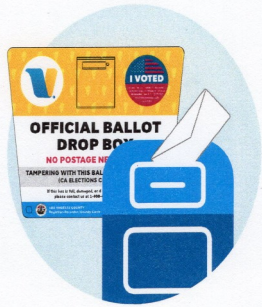

California Governor Recall Election

The 2021 California Governor Recall Election is on Tuesday, September 14, 2021. California voters will decide whether to recall the governor from office and choose a replacement to be governor.

What's on the ballot? There will be two questions to vote on:

1. Do you want to recall the governor?
2. If the governor is recalled, who do you want to replace him?

If more than 50% of voters say "no" to the first question, the governor remains in office.

If more than 50% of voters say "yes" to the first question, the person who gets the most votes on the second question becomes the governor.

So... vote NO on the FIRST question and leave the **second BLANK!**

The federal government's Emergency Rental Assistance Program can be used to cover up to 18 months of overdue rent and utility bills so more families can stay in their homes.

To find this help, go to consumerfinance.gov/renthelp and select the state and county where you live, and the website will connect you to programs you can apply for help in your local area.

We don't know how long the approval process could take in every city, but just starting the application process can be enough to keep you in your home.
