



August Is National Immunization Awareness Month

Keeping up to date on your children's vaccines is one of the most important actions parents can take to ensure a healthy future for their kids.

Parents can speak to their children's providers about a vaccine to protect against cancers caused by the Human Papilloma Virus (HPV). HPV causes almost all cervical cancers and many cancers of the vagina, penis, anus and throat.

If you have a child between 11-12, talk to their doctor about getting the HPV Vaccine. The HPV Vaccine is recommended for young men and women through age 26.

Women who have had the HPV Vaccine should still get treated regularly for cervical cancer (Pap Test). Check with your doctor about what vaccines you need.

Resources: The Vaccines for Children (VFC) program provides vaccines at no cost to children ages 18 years and younger who are uninsured or MediCal eligible.

Most insurances will cover the HPV vaccine or other vaccines as long as they are given according to the national guidelines.

Uninsured individuals may be able to receive some immunizations at no cost or reduced cost in Community Health and Public Health Centers.
