ADMINISTRATION

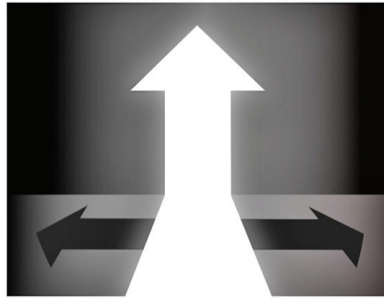

Hi,

As your Mayor I want to remind you about the importance of voting on July 30, 2024. *Your vote matters in the upcoming July 30th election!* The Mayor and Council races will be on the July Primary Election ballot. Waiting to vote until the November General Election may be too late!

I believe we are at a crossroads in Fountain Hills. The path we choose will affect whether or not our hometown remains the welcoming, friendly and inclusive community my family fell in love with more than 40 years ago. Can all residents expect to be represented and heard, or just the base of a few? Will the experience and professional credentials of staff and attorneys be respected, or will we be governed by hunch and anecdote? With me you make the choice to be civil and move forward together.

This is a non-partisan position and I've always treated it in that manner. In 2022, only about 200 votes separated me from Joe Arpaio, pardoned by Trump for racial profiling practices while Sheriff. 2024 puts us at another crossroads, with Arpaio challenging me again, along with Gerry Friedel, a Councilmember who once said Democratic voters hate America. We don't have to live with this chaotic, divisive climate... we've done fine for decades, safe, united and generous, and I know we can walk that walk again.

If you are on the active early voter list (AEVL), you will receive your ballot after July 3rd for the July 30 election. But remember, the post office does not forward official ballots.

IF you will be out-of-town you must make a special request to send your ballot to a different address.

You can do so by going to **www.BeBallotReady.Vote** to have your ballot sent to another address. *(It is a great resource for all your election needs.)* If you are not an early voter, you can request a ballot be mailed to you using the same **www.BeBallotReady.Vote** site OR vote in person anytime during July at a voting center in Fountain Hills, or on Election Day on July 30 (locations will be publicized well in advance.) I hope you will vote!

Finally, I want you to know that I believe Fountain Hills is a wonderful place to live, raise a family, work and enjoy all that our town and Arizona have to offer. I want to preserve our special quality of life ... the very reasons that you moved here... along with a thriving economy and beautiful amenities.

I hope that we can travel the right road together and keep Fountain Hills the jewel that it is. Please vote to keep me as your mayor in July.
