Pre-Registration Fee \$50. For returning students, is due on or before June 1,2024 Your space in the studio is not guaranteed until the registration fee and registration form are received. The registration fee will provide partial credit for the first month tuition



Private Instruction Tuition. Based on a 33 week term, 40 or 60 minute lessons, prorated on a 10-month basis: August 12, 2024 thru May 16, 2025.

Additional Costs

Books and Materials: A Material Fee of \$35 per year per student is required. You will be also invoiced for music books purchased as needed.



Master Classes are intended to enhance and prepare students for many performing opportunities. Four (4) 60minute group classes will be offered during the term, replacing private lessons. Please review the schedule posted in the music studio.



Attendance - Regular attendance at lessons and classes is essential for the student's success. Missed lessons will not be made up. Lessons missed by the teacher will be made up. Periodic make-up group classes will be scheduled throughout the term with a minimum of three students.



Practice - Successful piano study is dependent on correct and consistent practice habits.

- ♦ Check on your child's progress during the week.
- ♦ Provide a practice setting free from distractions
