Grant Application Guidelines

Overview:

The Paul Brown Legacy Foundation is committed to empowering lives through love, learning, and legacy. Our grants support organizations and initiatives that align with our core mission in the areas of education, community development, and health and wellness.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be:

- A registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization or have a fiscal sponsor.
- Operating within the United States.
- Able to demonstrate alignment with the Foundation's mission and funding priorities.

Funding Priorities:

1. Educational advancement for underserved communities.
2. Health and wellness programs.
3. Community and youth development initiatives.

Grant Types:

- Program Grants: For specific projects or programs.
- Capacity Building Grants: To strengthen organizational effectiveness.
- General Operating Support: For day-to-day operational costs.

Application Process:

Step 1: Submit a Letter of Inquiry (LOI)

- A brief summary (1-2 pages) of your organization, the proposed project, and its alignment with our mission.

Step 2: Invitation to Submit Full Proposal

- If selected, you will be invited to submit a full proposal including:
 - Organization background
 - Project description
 - Budget and sustainability plan
 - Evaluation metrics

Step 3: Review and Decision

- Proposals are reviewed by our Grant Committee.
- Decisions will be communicated within 8 weeks of submission.

Deadlines:

- LOIs are accepted on a rolling basis.
- Proposal invitations will be sent within 4 weeks of LOI submission.
