Five years ago (21 years ago), I received the scary news that my mother was dying of cancer quickly. It was already beginning to be metastasized. Our relationship with our mother made a radical shift.

Today I am filled with gratitude. I love my Mom. I love myself. I love my enemies. There is often confusion and really raw emotions. But I have the ability embedded deep within my soul to forgive and love unconditionally, through and through.

So often, our problem is desiring and arranging to go back through the waters. (Back to the way it was before the Corona pandemic.) Moses brought the people into the desert through the seas, the Dead Sea. For forty years the people wanted to go back. They couldn't see the New Heavens and the New Earth. Maybe they still want to go back. There is no return to the womb or enslaving someone who has been already freed. We are destined to become children of God for all eternity. We must imitate Our God... We must be like Jesus physically, spiritually and psychologically. The Body of Christ we eat and the Blood of Christ we drink is the only way to transition to heaven. The Blood of Christ was on the lips of my mother the moment she died to this world and passed over to heaven, love itself.

There will be no life unless we curb our appetites, our addictions, our meanness or feeling we are loved more than the poor.

God loves us. We need not fear anything else but God, our Father and Friend. Ooh & ah! O my.

With this in mind, let us remember that as people of faith, we don't want to miss God's gifts to us—they are, after all, from the Lord God Himself. And, they are given to us for our ultimate happiness!

God, the great gift-giver, is the one who gives life to every man and woman. This life is directed to the fullness of joy and eternity since the Lord God made men and women "in His image" (see Genesis 1: 27). God's gift of life is multifaceted. The gift of life unfolds to reveal many related gifts, all willed by God, including personhood—one's identity as a precious child of God; human sexuality with its fertility—the ability to co-create with the Lord of all creation; the capacity to love like God, to forgive, empathize, and form small communions of persons in families, friendships, businesses, citizenships, and so forth. Finally, as if all this were not enough, God crowns His creation with His ultimate gift of salvation through His son Jesus—"For God so loved the world that he gave His only Son so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life" (John 3:16).



HAPPY GRANDPARENT'S DAY!



***“Grandparents are the ring linking generations,
to transmit to young people the experience of life and faith.” Pope Francis (2021)***

Whether you are a grandparent or have a grandparent, you know that these words by Pope Francis are true. In fact, Pope Francis thinks grandparents are such an important part of our families that he named today World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly.

There is an inexplicable bond between grandparents and grandchildren. That bond begins the second we hold our grandchild for the first time. Something wondrous happens to our hearts! And that incredible feeling grows exponentially with each passing year. Grandchildren must be God’s rewarding gift to us for surviving parenthood! Amidst all the fun and games, though, we can easily forget that one of our primary God-given roles is to pass on our faith to each generation.

How can you share your faith with your grandchildren?

- Pray for them by name each day. Take your time. Be specific.
- Dream with them. Tell them your dreams and ask them about theirs. Listen attentively. Do what you can to help them achieve their dreams. Help them discover who God wants them to be.
- Let them catch you in the act of living your life for God. Be their role model. Walk the walk. They will ask you questions. Simply explain to them why you do the things you do.
- Help them experience holy moments. Pray with them. Read a children’s bible with them and help them learn to think as God thinks and not as the world thinks. What would Jesus do?
- Teach them to be generous and kind.
- Teach them to be thankful. Pray together at meals and let them lead the prayer sometimes.
- Teach them to pray at bedtime. Ask them what or who they would like to pray for. Join them in prayer.
- Use teachable moments to discuss what is the right thing to do in a situation.
- Share your relationship with God with them. Ask them about how God is with them in their own lives.

Being a grandparent means making memories together that will last long after you are gone. Make spiritual memories together that they can pass down to their own children and grandchildren. Tomorrow is the feast day of Jesus’s grandparents, St. Joachim and St. Anne. Ask them to help you be the best grandparent you can be for each of your grandchildren. 
