What does it mean to be a good "Catholic?" A good member of this fine parish?

This "job Description" is offered as something of a yardstick for your own, personal "self-evaluation"

Five Key Elements Make up the Christian Life:

Knowing the Story:

Showing awareness of what Jesus said and did, accomplished in the past, how He is active within us, what His disciples share. At Least, one owns a Bible, does some regular reading in it, and knows where to find the basic stories of our Faith.

Personal Prayer Life:

Meeting the Lord in private prayer, and being on the way to ever deeper Communion with God, the Source of all Life. At least, a commitment to a few moments daily given over to prayer and to growth in your relationship with Christ.

Regular Attendance at Worship:

Coming from one's private encounter with God in prayer, to public gatherings for sharing that faith in praise and petition. At least, a regular commitment to participation in weekend worship.

Stewardship; Involvement in Works of Charity and Justice:

Showing that one is making an effort to integrate corporal works of mercy as elements of Christian living. This also means a moral and charitable approach to all others in thought and action. At least, one could identify one's commitment in sharing substantial talent, income and effort with the parish, the wider church and the world community, if asked.

Social Involvement:

Beyond participation in our common worship, one takes part in parish educational and social gatherings. At least, one is registered in the parish, responds to inquiries and mailing promptly, keeps on top of parish news (parish bulletin), and participates in some parish activity


