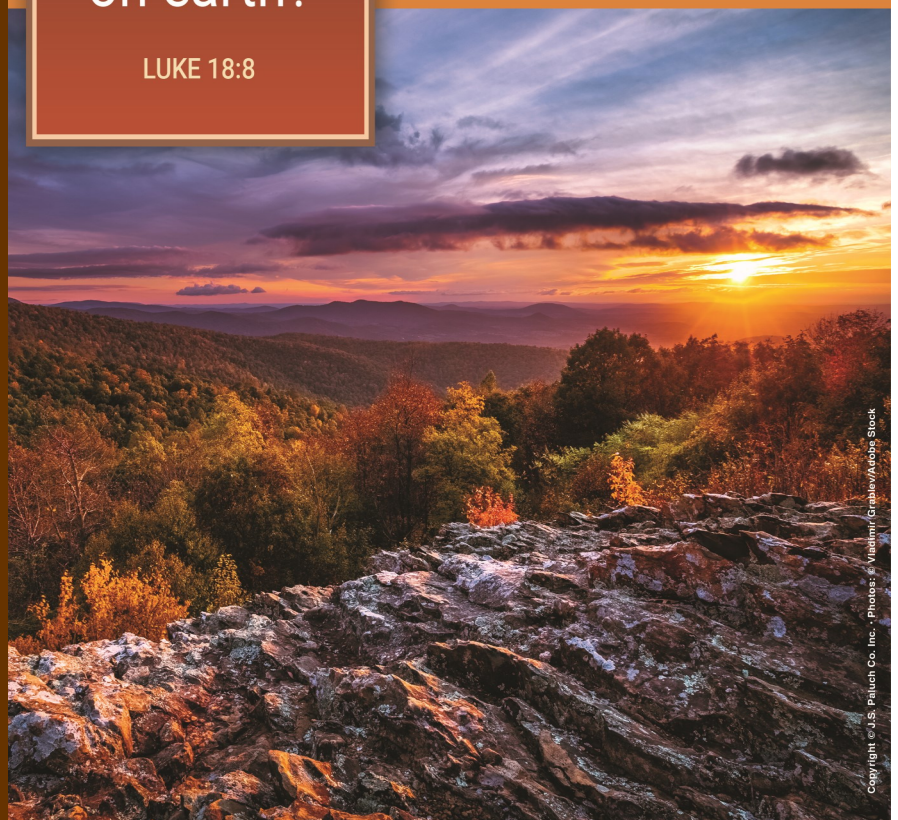

A note from the pastor

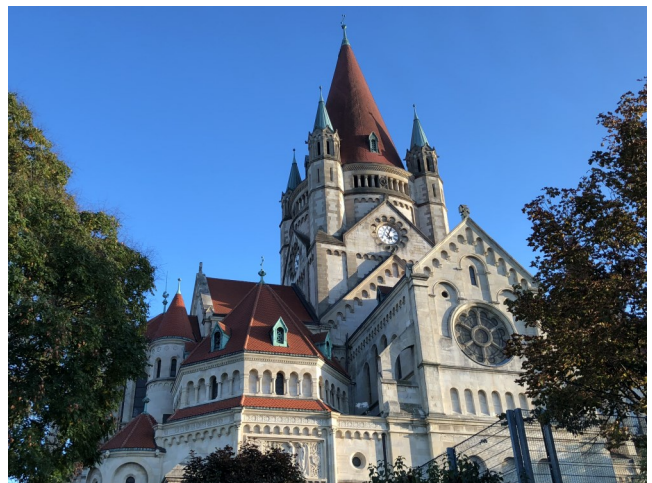
Dear Beloved of St Monica,

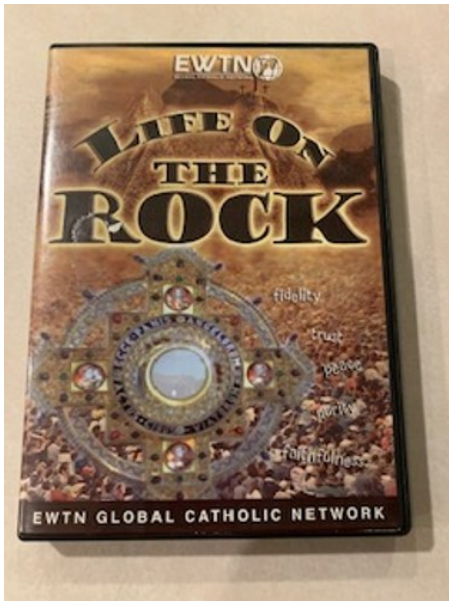

Journaling-Praying with a Pen

“Life with Christ is a wonderful adventure.” – St. John Paul II

When you were first in love, did you ever write love letters to your beloved? Have you ever thought of writing a love letter to God? God loves us more than anyone else can love us. The more we draw nearer to Him, the nearer He will draw to us. So how can we do that?

Start by carving out a little time from your day just to be with God. He'll be there waiting for you. First thing in the morning is best, while your mind is fresh and before your day gets away from you. If you need to, wake up a little earlier. You'll need a **quiet** place and a cup of coffee, tea, or hot chocolate. There is something relaxing about sipping on a hot drink that puts your mind in gear. Now all you need is paper and pen and you're ready!

Write down on paper just what you would say if you were talking to Him. You might want be specific and write to the Father, Jesus, or the Holy Spirit. Tell God what is on your mind. Tell him about what you have planned for your day. Ask Him if He has something you can do for him. If you are nervous, share your anxiety with Him. If you have a problem you have to face, share it with Him. If you are feeling guilty about something, tell Him about it and ask His forgiveness. If you have a friend in need, intercede for them by asking God for His help and grace. Sometimes, if you listen carefully, you will be answered with a Holy Whisper.

Journaling helps put into words the things that are in your heart.

The more you seek God, the more He will reveal Himself to you. Soon you will find this is the best time of your day!
