Beloved,

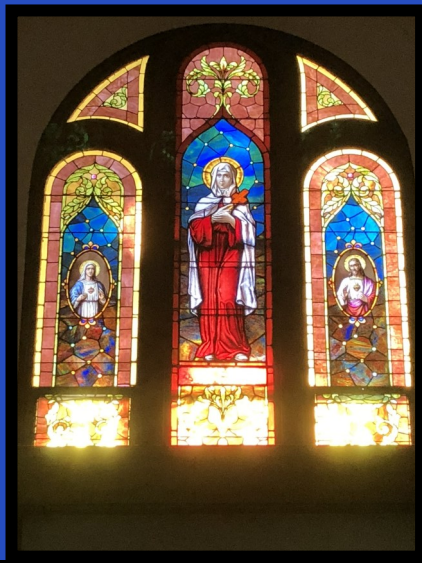
Wow! We truly celebrated the 160th birthday of St. Monica here in Palatka.

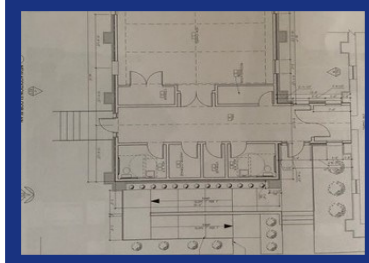

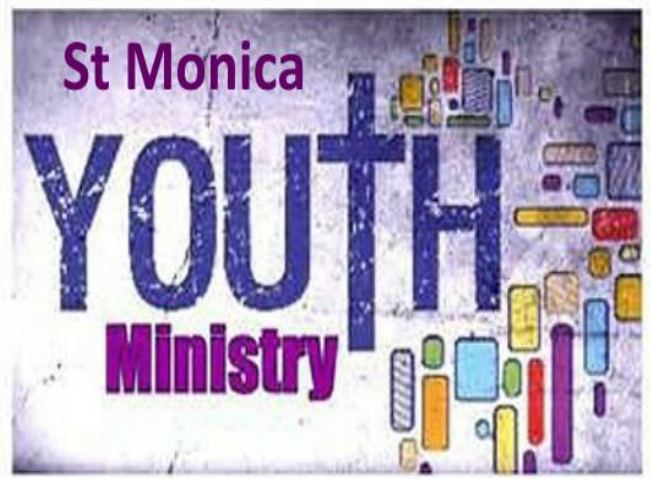


Welcome to the Foot of the Cross:

The Bible

St. Jerome once wrote,
“Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance
of Christ.”

Do you have a copy of the Bible in your
home?

Do you read it often?

Prayer and reading the Word of God are essential to growing in faith. Reading the Bible will show you how much God loves us by looking at his relationship with his people throughout time. He loves us so much he gave us his only Son for our salvation. Would you like to know Jesus better? Read the Gospels—Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. Spend at least 15-20 minutes every day pondering the words of Jesus and what he was trying to teach us. Read and reread them slowly, reflecting on every word. A Study Bible can be very helpful.

If you find that you need more help or that you would really like to go much deeper in your understanding of the Bible, join Father Ron’s Bible Study on Tuesdays at 6:15 p.m. in the library. Father Ron is a Bible Scholar and has extensive knowledge of Scripture. He will help guide you through the books of the Bible and help you interpret their chapters and verses.

If you have trouble reading small print, there are Bibles available in large print, or you can buy a Bible for your Kindle or Nook and adjust the font, or you can also use the Bible on the **Laudate** app on your phone or tablet and make it whatever size you need.
