Beloved Stewards,

Since 1858, 162 years ago, St. Monica has been celebrating Mass, remembering God's love at the altar on this little plot of land by the St. Johns River. We have done this through much suffering and sacrifice as we navigated the Civil War, World War I & II, devastating Orange Freeze, economic crashes and epidemics like malaria, flu of 1918, and corona virus. And yet we continued to thrive as the Body of Christ.

Here we are in the midst of political bitterness and lack of charity to simply listen to one another. The virus of hatred is far worse than the current Covid-19 that has disrupted our lives. If you are leaning to the right or to the left politically, we need to give God the gift of listening before we tweet or offer an opinion. Jesus teaches us to practice mercy and love always. This is hard work. This is the cross that Jesus insists we pick up and follow with.

"If today you hear God's voice, harden not your hearts." Psalm 95

You know as well as I do, that after all these years, voting only on one issue has not changed the current horror. Vote whichever way you choose, but I would like to suggest that there are other issues that contribute to the sin of abortion and the misery of victims of oppression, the poor, and the voiceless. We, as Catholics, need to consider all the issues. Moral integrity matters.

Voting just on one issue like abortion will be mute if God's laws that protect fairness, equality, economic fairness, the young mother with child, a sustainable wage, health care, social security, the poor, the environment, education or nuclear/war de-escalation are ignored. There are no perfect candidates, but there are many neglected issues that affect all of us.

Whenever we treat others without love, no matter how horrific their sins, we will have to give an account to God, for the plank is obvious in our own eye.

If we do not teach all children the essential commandment of love in all situations, they will not learn them, and we will be held accountable as Ezekiel is quite clear today. Jesus warns us clearly that a house divided cannot stand. Unless we are able to civilly discuss all of the moral issues with one another, the United States will fall like all former empires and nations. It is not only our infrastructure that is crumbling.

It seems to me that there are two languages, one of the far right and one of the far left. Neither side is able to understand each other.

Saint Augustine, like Ezekiel the prophet helps us to understand in a sermon called, “*A Lesson from Babel 2.*” (Sermon 54, 11)


Remember the tower that certain proud people built after the flood? What was their intention? They said: “Let us construct a high tower (or wall). We don’t want to perish in another flood.” They tried to build such a high tower, but the Lord confused their speech. They no longer could understand each other. Up to that time they all spoke the same language because one language was enough for a humble people who were of one mind. But then that unity degenerated into a prideful conspiracy against God. God then took action, coming down and mixing up their speech so that they could not form further dangerous alliances by understanding each other.

The second lesson about pride contained in the story of the Tower of Babel is that pride makes communication between humans difficult, if not impossible. Pride prevents us from understanding another’s point of view because we cannot transcend our own point of view. It takes great humility to sit silently and listen to another; sometimes it takes even greater humility to ask, “Now what did you mean by that?” (*Day By Day with St Augustine*: D. Burt)

When we fail to ask this question, we judge another... which means that instead of mercy from God... we will be judged.

Feeding the Hungry

*Jesus said to them, “There is no need for them to go away; give them some food yourselves.”

Two thousand years later, Jesus still says, “They need not go away; you give them something to eat.” People are still hungry and need to be fed. These days at St. Monica food pantry, there are three times as many people as usual who need to be fed. Some days we, too, say, “Five loaves and two fish are all we have here.”

And then Jesus works a miracle. Parishioners drop off bags of non-perishable food. Generous people donate money to the Poor Fund to help purchase much needed food items. The Farm Share truck pulls up and fills our refrigerators with fresh produce and our freezers with frozen meat. People, young and old, volunteer to bag and box the food and put it in cars as they drive by on Saturday morning.

No one goes away hungry. Some need food. Some need a kind word. Some need a smile. As they drive away, they know that we at St. Monica care and Jesus loves them.






