


GLORY IN THE CROSS

When violence seeks to destroy us, hold on to Love.


Acts of compassion restore us. **Hold on to Love**.

3. When hatred is used to divide us, hold on to Love.


Wisdom and truth reunite us. Hold on to Love.


When prejudice poses as freedom, **hold on to Love**.

Dignity means "all are welcome!" Hold on to Love.


