

JEFFERSONTOWN VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK

The Jeffersontown Veterans Memorial Park is a 27-acre site located in Jeffersontown, Kentucky on Taylorsville Road (State Road #155). The City of Jeffersontown has magnanimously designated this community recreational area as a tribute to the nation's veterans. It stands as a reminder to the community of the commitment and sacrifice that many Americans have made, and still make, to insure our nation's freedom.

An area to the right of the main entrance is designated 'The Walk of Veterans' and is made up of approximately 6,000 brick pavers. The brick pavers are available for inscription to honor veterans and servicemembers. A brick paver is a permanent remembrance and tribute to someone who served or is currently serving our country.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Brick pavers are available for the public to honor Americans who have honorably served or are currently serving in the United States Armed Forces. The veteran/servicemember need not be a resident of Jeffersontown nor the Commonwealth of Kentucky to have a brick paver.

Inscription orders should be received by the first of April to be installed by Memorial Day and the first of September to be installed by Veterans Day.

HOW IT WORKS ...

The cost is \$150.00 per brick paver, which may be tax deductible. All proceeds will go the Jeffersontown Veterans Memorial Park Fund. Funds are used for brick pavers, memorial expansion in the park and to support veteran's causes.

NOTES REGARDING INSCRIPTIONS

Each 4"x8" brick paver has three lines of inscription. Maximum 14 characters per line including spaces.

The first line consists of the veteran's name, the second line is the branch of service and rank and/or unit if space allows. Abbreviations strongly recommended. The third line is years of service. War service and/or ship service may be included if space allows. If the person is still serving, just list the date service began. Broken service can be denoted as per example. The information will automatically be centered on the brick. It is not necessary to center the information on the order. No punctuation marks please.

The following symbols, not part of the 14-character line, can be inscribed on the brick pavers:

- ★ DEATH WHILE SERVING
- ♥ PURPLE HEART MEDAL/WOUNDED IN ACTION
- PRISONER OF WAR (POW)
- ▲ MISSION IN ACTION (MIA)
