

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session October 16, 2018 at 6:30 PM

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm, by Mayor Rick Geike. Present were council members Gary Sacher, Honey Grant, Marvin Edison, Allan Rothlisberg, and Robert Rodney. Also present was, Janet Young, Chief Shawn Peirano, Jerome Thomas, Diane Nelly, Rocky Thurman, Officer Wyatt Charlson.

Mayor Geike led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Honey Grant led the Invocation.

Honey Grant made a motion to approve the September 18, 2018 minutes. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Diane Nelly requested that the council approve returning the water deposit to the customers. After much discussion Robert Rodney made a motion to return \$75.00 of the water deposit to customers after 24 consecutive months of on time payments. If at any time during that 24 months a payment is late, then the customer is not eligible for a refund until another 24 months have passed. The customer must request the return of water deposit in writing. A form will be made available at City Hall. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jerome Thomas advised the council of the following:

- 1) Thanked the council on behalf of Kansas Rural Water for the use of the community center and advised that they would like to use it again for training on 1/15/2019
- 2) Advised that he ordered and had delivered 3 loads of sand.
- 3) Advised he had ordered the Halloween candy.
- 4) Requested to purchase tires for the John Deere tractor for \$2104.66. Gary Sacher made a motion to purchase the tires. Allen Rothlisberg seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Chief Peirano advised the council of the following:

- 1) Advised council that the police department had responded to 358 calls for service.
- 2) Advised council that the body armor of 4 people is getting ready to expire. Presented a quote from Armor Express for \$4703.00. Robert Rodney made a motion to purchase the body armor. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

- 3) Advised the council that there has problems with radio reception inside the building and that he had KaComm come and make sure that their equipment was running properly. Advised the council that he would need to get a base station and antennae on the back of building, however, there is some of the equipment needed already in the office.
- 4) Advised the council that the hand held radar unit is inoperable and he is unable to fix it. Advised that he may be requesting the purchase another one soon.
- 5) Advised the council that Unit1 was not running correctly and that it would be approximately \$600.00 to fix.
- 6) Requested \$1000.00 to be donated for Shop with a Cop. Robert Rodney made the motion to donate the money. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
- 7) Advised that Officer DiPolito had approached him about leaving to move the South Carolina. After discussion, the council advised that if he or any other officer leaves prior to the end of their 3 year contract, then they would be responsible for paying back the city at a pro-rated amount.
- 8) Advised the council that he would try to have someone hired by the end of this week.

Janet Young advised the council of the following:

- 1) Thanked council for giving permission for her to go to training in November. Advised council that all the candy and bags are in for the Halloween parade.
- 2) Asked council if they wanted to adopt 3 senior citizen families for Thanksgiving. Robert Rodney made the motion to approve \$300.00 to spend for the 3 families. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
- 3) Asked council about adopting 3 families (children) for Christmas. Robert Rodney made the motion to approve \$2500.00 for the gifts for the 3 families. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
- 4) Asked is Honey Grant was going to purchase individual gifts for the children at school. Marvin Edison approved \$300.00 to purchase gifts. Robert Rodney seconded the motion.

Gary Sacher moved to approve the September expenditures, seconded by Honey Grant. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Honey Grant moved to approve the September financial statement, seconded by Gary Sacher. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Allen Rothlisberg made a motion to adjourn. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
