

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session June 21, 2022 at 5:30 PM

Meeting was called to order at 5:30 pm, by Mayor Rick Geike. Present were council members, Ronald Woods, Honey Grant, Art Potter, and Harlan Lofthus. Also present were, Janet Young, Chief Peirano, Roger Unruh, Jeremy Bramwell, Luke Erichsen, Silas Keim, Samantha Boyd, Marvin Edison, Tanya Thurn, John Day, George Edmonson, Justin Johnson and Cheryl Boyd.

Mayor Geike led the Pledge of Allegiance

Honey Grant led the Invocation.

Ronald Woods made a motion to approve the May 17, 2022 minutes. Art Potter seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Mayor Geike appointed Tanya Thurn as council member to fill empty seat. Honey Grant made a motion to approve the appointment. Harlan Lofthus seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Janet Young swore Tanya Thurn in as council member.

Luke Erichsen advised the council of the following:

- 1) Advised the council that all the park supplies are in except the fountains and that they were working on the park.
- 2) Advised council that he would be closing the tree limb pile on 6/30/2022.
- 3) Advised that he would be purchasing hot mix asphalt at \$75.00 ton from Byers to fill pot holes, when it dried up enough to fill pot holes.
- 4) Advised that Colin Glessner had finished the demolition of the last two properties.
- 5) Suggested that the council consider charging citizens for reread on water meters. Advised Junction City charges \$10.00 if reading was correct. If reading was incorrect, there is no charge.

Jeremy Bramwell advised the council of the following:

- 1) Advised council of the calls for service for the fire department for the month.
- 2) Advised council he had hired Charles Labarro and Drew Sabine as volunteer firefighters.
- 3) Advised that Luke Erichsen has been named the Assistant Fire Chief.
- 4) Advised the council that the fire department boots, gloves and helmets are old and in need of replacement. He advised that he was looking at replacing them slowly and going to conduct fund raising events to help with the costs.
- 5) Advised council that the fire department would be involved with the MDA "fill the boot" event in September.

Chief Peirano advised the council of the following:

- 1) Advised that they responded to 418 calls for service.
- 2) Advised Tyler Hynes would be graduating July 29, 2022 from the academy.

Janet Young advised the council of the following:

- 1) Advised the council that Cat Cans was going to start charging a fuel surcharge due to the cost of fuel. Tanya Thurn made the motion to have portable bathrooms removed from park. Seconded by Art Potter. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Council discussed changing the city ordinance pertaining to age of mobile homes allowed to come into city. After a short discussion it was determined that the council would hold a special meeting on 6/28/2022 at 5:30 pm to discuss this matter.

Art Potter moved to approve the May expenditures, seconded by Harlan Lofthus. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Ronald Woods moved to approve the May financial statement, seconded by Harlan Lofthus. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
