First you will need to visit allstarlink.org to register and setup a server and request a node number. It is a very simple process that should take no more than a few minutes. You are verified as a ham by your QRZ page. You should have an email address there for return information. Once you receive your node number and password you need to fill out this form with the additional information requested.
