The following data needs to be provided for us to setup your node. If you are setting up your own node you will need this info during the setup process so have it handy. First you will need to visit all starlink.org to register and setup a server and request a node number. It is a very simple process that should take no more than a few minutes. You are verified as a ham by your QRZ page. You should have an email address there for return information. Once you receive your node number and password you need to fill out this form with the additional information requested.

The node number and node password are assigned to you at allstarlink.org The node is a 5 digit number and the password is 12 alphanumeric characters. Older passwords are 6 digits. Case matters.
