Tribal casinos face a unique mix of regulatory, technological, and competitive challenges and opportunities. Although many operate both Class II and Class III gaming, Class II operations still contend with outdated regulations that lag modern gaming technology,

especially in areas like mobile platforms, cybersecurity, and fraud prevention. Legal disputes over game classification and tribal sovereignty add uncertainty, while competition from commercial Class 3, VLT, HHR, and unregulated gray market pressures revenue and player retention. At the same time, tribes must innovate strict federal definitions, manage public perception, and navigate NIGC regulations while ensuring gaming revenue continues to support essential tribal services.
