Morning Worship this Sunday

We are going to do something a little unusual this Easter Sunday. We will observe the Lord's Supper on Easter. You cannot have a resurrection without a death and so the cross and the empty tomb go together. One of the best sermons I ever heard on Easter was: *"It's Friday but Sundays' Coming"*

The Lord's Supper in the Gospels was Jesus observing the Passover meal with his friends. The Bible calls his followers disciples and Jesus calls them his friends. (Jn 14). He did something else, he asked, "Who are my brothers and sisters? They are those who do the will of my Father." The Book of Hebrews says Jesus is "not ashamed" to call us his brothers and sisters.

The pastor preached the reasons he believed that Jesus would return in his lifetime and one of his members looked very distraught. He asked him if he had doubts about his salvation and was afraid of Jesus' return. He said, No pastor, I thought about some of the things I have been doing and don't want to be ashamed when he comes, While you were preaching I rededicated my life to please him and obey him and all that I do.

Have you ever thought about the fact that Jesus called God his Father and he tells us to call God our Father. The Church is described in different ways but the one I love the most, the one I feel most true in my life, is seeing the Church as a family.

It takes a village to raise a child and my village for my children is the churches I have pastored and am pastoring now. If you have gotten out of the habit of attending church please pray about and think joining your brothers and sisters in Meadowbrook Baptist Church this as we observe the Lord's Supper together.
