# OUR FATHER IN HEAVEN

"When you pray, say, 'Our Father'."

-Jesus in Matthew 6:9

"This is what the Lord says, / 'As a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you'."

(Isaiah 66:13)

The first goal in praying, is to have a sense of making contact with God. Jesus tells us to go into a room and close the door. We must get away from the million-and-one things that are whirling around us and in our minds. What has helped me, is to have a *special place* of prayer. I go there, not to study or think about my day; I go there to talk to my heavenly Father. For me, it is a chair in front of a window, where I can look into the woods by my house. The morning after I was converted, I walked out to go to work and feeling the warmth of the sun and hearing the singing of birds, I sang:
