Why the Bible is God's Word

"Before things spring into being, I will announce them to you." (Isaiah 42:8-9)

One proof that the Bible is God's Word is fulfilled prophecy. Justin Martyr said, "To declare a thing will come to pass, and have it come to pass - this, or nothing, is the work of God."

Ezekiel said the mighty nation of <u>Egypt</u>, the breadbasket of the East, would <u>not</u> be destroyed, but would never rise again to prominence. It would be small among the nations (Ezekiel 29:14-16). It is just that today. Visiting there in the 1970's, I saw poverty in the streets, and dead cows floating in the Nile.

But the Bible said the <u>opposite</u> of <u>Babylon</u>. Isaiah predicted it <u>would</u> fall, and **never be** *Inhabited again* (Isaiah 13:19-22). This seemed ridiculous. It was the Queen City of the world, like Washington or London. It was strategically located and covered over 196 square miles. Its wall, with 250 watch towers, in some places was hundreds of feet high, and wide enough on top for chariots to race side by side. Its hanging gardens were one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. Its high buildings and broad streets were beautified by its magnificent system of canals. Today, it cannot be found with any degree of certainty. It is buried under the sand with no inhabitants.
