

DAY ONE Saturday, February 22

The Great Australian Bight Air Safari starts at Port Fairy, a historic fishing town in the southwest of Victoria between Warrnambool and Portland.

Many of Port Fairy's early buildings remain from its days as a port for sealers and whalers back in the 1800s. Port Fairy is home to Victoria's oldest continuously licensed hotel, The Caledonian Inn, "aka The Stump" dates back to 1844.

For early arrivals, there are several walking trails to explore Port Fairy, with the museum on the Moyne River worth visiting. There are also plenty of choices of cafés and bars, along with several art galleries and studios.

Dinner that evening will be at one of the excellent restaurants.


DAY TWO Sunday, February 23

A late morning start provides plenty of time to arrive at Kingscote, Kangaroo Island, by early afternoon. Note, there is no AVGAS at Kngscote, with Goolwa being an en-route option.

If not done on arrival at Port Fairy, there could be an opportunity to backtrack about 30 miles for a view of the Twelve apostles from the air.

Following the rugged southwest coast of Victoria, the sweep of Long Bay between Kingston SE and Victor Harbour, and the crystal-clear waters surrounding the Fleurieu Peninsular should provide for many photos.

DAY THREE Monday, February 24

Today is an opportunity to tour the southern coast of Kangaroo Island. Highlights include visiting Seal Bay, to observe a colony from an 800-meter boardwalk of Sea Lions. Seal Bay has been their home for thousands of years.

The nearby Vivonne Bay is where we stop for lunch. It is a six-kilometer-long U-shaped beach with crystal-clear shallow water and was once voted Australia's best beach.

The tour reaches the southwest corner of the island - the renowned Flinders Chase National Park.

There are many photo opportunities here Cape du Couedic Lighthouse, the surreal shapes of the Remarkable Rocks, and the Admirals Arch an impressive rock arch weathered over thousands of years, but also home to a colony of long-nosed fur seals.

DAY FOUR Tuesday, February 25

For the flight to Ceduna, a suggested route is to first track to Flinders Reach, then via south Spencer Gulf Islands to Port Lincoln, before following the west coast of the Eyre Peninsular to Flinders Island, where we have lunch.

Privately owned by the Woolford family, Flinders Island has become an ecotourism destination, transitioning from a sheep station since the mid-2000s.

DAY FIVE Wednesday, February 26

Today's flying highlight is the Bunda Cliffs, starting at the Head of the Bight and stretching west to Eucla, just inside the Western Australia border. These limestone cliffs, some 60-120 meters (200-390 ft) in height, are over 100 kilometers long, making them the longest uninterrupted sea cliffs in the world.

Eucla's claim to fame is its telegraph station.n The East-West Telegraph line, built in 1875-77, was the final link in Australia's telegraph infrastructure and connected all five colonies.

The stone telegraph station was built in 1898, replacing the weatherboard station began operations on 9 December 1877.

The Eucla Telegraph Station ceased operation in 1927, and its ruins are slowly disappearing under the encroaching dunes. At its peak, it was handling 600 telegraphs per day and was home to 26 telegraphists and their families.

DAY SIX Thursday, February 27

The flight today, can provide another opportunity to view the Bunda Cliffs. Aircraft requiring fuel can go via the Nullabor Roadhouse. Elliston, on the west coast of the the Eyre Peninsula, is our lunch stop.

Elliston, with its rugged, scenic coastline considered some of the most spectacular on the Eyre Peninsula, has a reputation for its fishing, swimming, surfing and bushwalking.

With a hinterland of rolling hills, it is also a significant center for cereal-growing, mixedfarming as well as fishing. All aircraft should arrive at Clare Valley airfield no later than 4 pm, providing ample time to settle in, perhaps accompanied by a glass of one of Clare Valley's renowned Reislings..

DAY SEVEN Friday, February 28

With several hire cars, there is lots of flexibility in how you would like to spend a day in Clare Valley, with its cluster of wineries, villages, and pristine farmlands.

For example, there are many cellar doors available for wine tastings. A good start to locate these is the 35-kilometer Riesling Trail, which could be done on a hire bike.

A significant heritage building worth visiting is Martindale Hall at Mintaro, an outstanding example of the grand country mansions constructed by wealthy pastoralists.

Edmund Bowman Snr purchased 9,159 acres around Mintaro, in the mid-nineteenth century and named the property Martindale Station. Edmund Jr commissioned Martindale Hall to be built in 1879 – 1880 for £30,000. The building has 32 rooms of which 7 of these are for a cellar. No expense was spared on outdoor facilities, such as a polo ground, racecourse, a boating lake, and a cricket pitch where the English 11 played at least once.

The final dinner of the Safari will be at one of the fine restaurants found in Clare, perhaps proceeded by Friday night drinks at the Clare Valley Wine, Food and Tourism Centre.




