

Alternative accommodation for Sweers Island is the Savannah Lodge at Burketown, plus two breakfasts, two dinners, lunch at Sweers Island, and the Gumbamanda Sunset Cruise. Pricing will be reduced by \$475 and \$275 per person for double / twin share and single occupancy respectively for this option.

Alternative accommodation for Badu Island is one night at Merluna Station and an extra night at Cooktown, plus one lunch, one breakfasts and one dinner at Merluna Station, use of a 4WD including fuel to explore Cooktown. Pricing will be reduced by \$500 and \$225 per person for double / twin share and single occupancy respectively for this option.

A deposit of \$1,500 per person is required to secure your place.

DAY ONE Saturday 9 August

This year, the safari begins in Hughenden, a well-presented small outback town located halfway between Townsville and Mount Isa.

Hughenden was established in the early 1860s, following a glowing report by William Landsborough about the region's fine grasslands, which triggered a rush of pastoralists.

If you plan to arrive in the early afternoon, you will have time for a short tour of the town, visit the impressive fossil collection at the Flinders Discovery Centre, and enjoy an outback sunset from Mount Walker, which offers stunning views of Hughenden.

Before heading off to Sweers Island, there will be an opportunity to visit Porcupine Gorge, located about an hour's drive to the north.

Carved out by Porcupine Creek, the gorge stretches for over 25 kilometers and has a depth of up to 120 meters, revealing layers of sedimentary rock that span hundreds of millions of years.

On the way back, you will be dropped off at Hughenden Airport, with a brief stopover at Burketown for fuel before proceeding to Sweers Island.

DAY THREE Monday 11 August

The warm waters of the Gulf of Carpentaria provide excellent fishing opportunities, and Sweers Island is ideally located to take advantage of this.

The island was a refuge for survivors when malaria struck Burketown in 1866.

You can use one of the several boats available at the resort to explore and find a fishing spot or go on a charter for a better chance of catching a big one.

All meals, including freshly caught fish, are provided during your stay at Sweers Island.

About 50 kilometers from the Northern Territory lies Hell's Gate Roadhouse, established in the mid-1980s as part of the adjoining Cliffdale Station.

Hell's Gate got its name from a nearby gap that the road passes through. In the early days of the Gulf settlement, troublemakers were escorted to Hell's Gate with instructions to walk to Katherine and not return!

To gain insight into how a cattle station operates, it is well worth taking a two-hour tour of Cliffdale Station in the afternoon.

A late morning departure will get you to Karumba by lunchtime, which serves as the home port for an extensive fleet of prawn trawlers.

Karumba has a significant aviation heritage; in 1937, it became a refueling point for Qantas and BOAC flying boats traveling from Australia to London. Additionally, during World War II, the town served as an RAAF base for Catalinas flying into New Guinea, Timor, and Indonesia.

An afternoon cruise will first take you down the Norman River for a town tour, where you may often see crocodiles on the mudflats

Then you will head to a sand island just off the coast, the perfect location to witness a famous Karumba sunset, accompanied by drinks, nibbles, and freshly cooked Gulf prawns.

After breakfast, we will embark on the longest flying day of the safari to Horn Island. Towards the end of the flight, a small detour will provide aerial views of Cape York.

Planning for an early afternoon arrival, there should be ample time for a tour of Thursday Island or a leisurely stroll exploring the area.

In the evening, around 5:30 PM, we will board the Nekana II for a dinner cruise, enjoying a spectacular sunset over the Arafura Sea.

Departing Thursday Island for Cape York

This morning, we will leave around 7 AM for a cruise on the Nekana II to continental Australia's northernmost point. While enjoying breakfast, we will cruise through sheltered waters, passing Prince of Wales, Roko, and Possession Islands.

The anchor will be dropped late morning in view of the tip. The Dory will transfer you to the mainland, where you can take a short walk for a photo opportunity.

After lunch on the return trip, it is possible that the boat could stop by Friday Island, where you may have the chance for a swim.

That evening, enjoy traditional dance, storytelling, and a musical show, followed by dinner.

Following breakfast, we will head down to the wharf to catch the ferry over to Horn Island. The aim is to fly a route that will get us to Badu Island by noon, possibly taking us via Darnley and Mabuiag Islands to showcase the stunning Torres Strait.

Upon arrival at Badu Island, you will be greeted and taken to the Badu Island Art Centre to gain insight into Torres Strait culture and perhaps purchase an artwork or a unique memento.

After enjoying lunch at the Art Centre, a 30-minute drive will take you to the remote northwest of the island to Alup, with its private beach.

You will have plenty of time to settle in and enjoy dinner, which will likely include freshly caught crayfish.

DAY NINE Sunday 17 August

The facilities at Alup, consist of one small openair shack for sleeping and another for cooking and gathering.

Additional tents are provided to accommodate our group, or you can choose to sleep beside the fire on the beach. It is that sort of place!

Alup is a unique tourist destination, so much so that Forbes Magazine voted it one of the top 50 tourist destinations in the world.

Your "rest day" at Alup is yours to enjoy. You can walk along the white sandy beach or swim in the crystal-clear tropical waters. Perhaps you might want to help catch dinner.

At low tide, you can access some rocks from the shore, which are abundant with crayfish. Nancy, the owner, along with others who may drop by, will share their knowledge of island cuisine, weaving, and the rich culture of the islands.

After saying farewell to Alup, you will be driven to Badu Island Airport. The first stop for the day will be at Merluna Station for morning tea.

The next stop is likely to be at Coen for fuel. It is recommended that you track via Lizard Island to Cooktown to experience the beauty of the Great Barrier Reef from the air.

That evening, enjoy a sunset cruise along the Endeavour River, where you might spot a crocodile lurking in the mangroves!

Today's tour will first take us to the Curtain Fig Tree, located a couple of kilometers from Yungaburra. This giant strangler fig has aerial roots that drop 15 meters to the ground and is estimated to be around 500 years old.

Before we stop off at the Malanda Hotel, Australia's largest wooden pub, we will visit Shaylee Strawberry Farm for morning tea and Gallo Dairyland for a cheese and chocolate tasting.

After lunch, we will visit Millaa Millaa Falls, renowned as one of the most photographed falls in all of Australia, and tranquil Lake Barrine, a crater lake adorned with towering bull kauri pine trees.

The flight today will showcase the stunning scenery of North Queensland. You will also fly around Magnetic Island at Townsville.

Finally, you will soar over the beautiful Whitsunday Islands and fly past Whitehaven Beach before landing at Shute Harbour Airport.
