

Itinerary Monday 1 to Sunday 14 May

DAY ONE - Monday 1 May

Welcome to the Kimberley Air Safari 2023; where we start at the Drysdale River Station. It is quite an adventure just getting here!

For example, coming from Brisbane, Melbourne or Sydney, expect a three-day journey in a Cessna 172 or Piper PA28 type aircraft.

Your route will take you through the outback and over the Tanami Desert. The name Tanami is thought to be an anglicisation of the Warlpiri name for the area, "Chanamee", meaning "never die". This referred to certain rock holes in the desert which were said never to run dry

After a few days flying, you will be welcomed with a cool drink under the shade of an Australian Morton Bay fig tree. Meeting everyone for the first time, starting memories and friendships that will last a lifetime.

Communication is possible via an Optus 3G mobile, Satellite phone or a payphone housed in a small fridge!

Mitchell Falls

Early start today for a visit to Mitchell Falls, one of the Kimberley's iconic waterfalls.

Also known as Punamii-Uunpuu to the Wunambal people, the falls were carved through sandstone by the waters of the Mitchell River, producing layers of mesmerising emerald water pools from which the waters tumble from one to the next.

A relay of helicopters will transfer the group from the Mitchell Plateau airfield (YMIP) to Mitchell Falls. A short hike from here will take you Little and Big Mertens Falls, with some fine examples of early Aboriginal rock art.

One rock in the Wandjina complex in the Mirchell Plateau area, is known as the Thylacine rock and depicts Tasmanian tigers, extinct on mainland Australia for 3,000 years. The return helicopter trip will orbit Mitchell Falls.

The flight to Cygnet Bay, today, promises spectacular scenic flying. Starting from Mount Hann follow the Prince Regent River and its many gorges to the spectacular Kings Cascades waterfall, where the Prince Regent River water cascades over ancient terraced rock formations.

The distinctive Mount Trafalgar is only a short distance from here. The track can then take you over Kuri Bay Pearl Farm, Montgomery Reef which at 300 square kilometres the world's largest inshore reef, Horizontal Waterfalls and Buccaneer Archipelago for a truly memorable flight.

Today is an opportunity to visit Broome, which is only a short flight away from Cygnet Bay.

The Broome tour will take you to Cable Beach, Gantheaume Point, Broome Wharf, Town Beach, Japanese Cemetery and Chinatown, providing an excellent overview of Broome's history - particularly its pearling industry.

Lunch overlooking Cable Beach has been arranged at Zanders.

DAY FIVE – Friday 5 May (Non Flying Day)

The stay at Cygnet Bay has been timed to coincide greatest tidal ranges, which in turn is the best time to enjoy "Sea Safaris".

The Waterfall Reef Sea Safari will take you to a reef where you will witness the spectacle of water cascading of an exposed reef at low tide.

With the Giant Tides Sea Safari you cruise amongst the giant whirlpools and standing tidal waves which are powered by the world's largest tropical tides.

On both sea safaris, experience boarding your amphibian vessel from a "land dock", which subsequently transfers you to a moored boat offshore that will do the tour.

The day trip, today, will take us to Windjana Gorge about 70 nautical miles east of Derby. The airstrip is a short walk to the start of the Gorge.

The Gorge Trail follows the long languid pools and sandy riverbed of the Lennard River, surrounded by 300 metre high walls, where you are likely to see numerous fresh water crocodiles.

The return can take you via Derby, and the option to see Derby Wharf and the Prison Boab Tree.

DAY SEVEN AND EIGHT Sunday 7 and Monday 8 May (Non Flying Days)

For the remaining two days at Cygnet Bay, one suggestion is to go on Terry Hunter's enjoyable Borrgoron Coast to Creek Tour. Learn traditional methods how to find fresh water and food on the tidal flats, as well as being regaled with a few stories.

Find some time to learn about Pearling, by going on the Pearl Farm Discovery Tour, or just relax by the pool with its stunning outlook. As it is full moon during your stay, there is a chance to observe the Staircase to the Moon from the Luna Bar,

Today's flight will take you from Cygnet Bay to Kununurra. If you haven't managed to top up your tanks on one of the day trips, you may need to detour via Derby.

The eastbound track out of Cygnet Bay should provide another chance to see the Horizontal Waterfalls.

Lunch, accompanied by scones has been arranged at Ellenbrae Station, a 400,000 hectare (1 million acre) property, which has become a popular Gibb River Road stopover for travelers.

The short flight into Kununurra will take you over the majestic orange cliffs of Cockburn Range.

The Cockburn Range is shaped like a vast round fortress and rises more than 600 metres above the plains.

The activity for this day, is a scenic flight to the mighty King George Falls, which is Western Australia's highest twin waterfall. First stop is Wyndham about a half hour flight from Kununurra for lunch at the Croc Café and Bakery

The scenic route to get to the falls is to track up the Cambridge Gulf and then follow the coast in a north westerly direction.

The flight Wyndham to King George Falls and back to Kununurra should take about three hours, getting you back around mid afternoon.

DAY ELEVEN - Thursday 11 May (Non Flying Day)

A ninety minute road trip from Kununurra gets you to El Questro. Before reaching El Questro, we will stop off at Emma Gorge, which is set beneath 65-metre cliffs with a droplet waterfall. Lunch will follow at the Emma Gorge resort.

During the afternoon, cruising on tranquil Chamberlain Gorge, you are likely to come across see cheeky spitting Archerfish and large Barramundi swimming near the boat.

DAY TWELVE - Friday May 12 (Non Flying Day)

Today in Kununurra is an opportunity for a full day tour of the Ord River and Lake Argyle.

Starting out, the cruise navigates the narrow, fast-flowing sections to the Ord through many gorges.

You may spot a myriad of bird and marine life along the way, including freshwater Crocodiles – there are over 5,000 in Lake Kununurra.

Later in the day, you cross the dam wall enroute to Lake Argyle Village and the historic Durack Homestead Museum.

Then board another boat for a cruise of North Lake Argyle, which is often referred to as the inland sea – being 21 times the size of Sydney Harbour at full capacity.

While on Lake Argyle, there will be time for a swim and being able to enjoy watching the sunset on the water.



The final day of the 2023 Kimberley Air Safari will be spent at the Bungle Bungles, about a 1 hour flight from Kununurra.

The highlight for today is the Cathedral Gorge and Domes Guided Walk. The track into Cathedral Gorge follows the sandy bed of Piccaninny Creek, which flows only in the wet season.

The Bungle Bungles, noted for its distinctive striped beehive domes, is known officially as the Purnululu National Park, was "discovered" by a film crew in 1983. It is one of the only nineteen heritage listed locations in Australia.
