Children's Home Society of California (CHS) offers subsidized child care programs to help pay for most or all of your child care expenses. You may select a child care provider that meets the needs of your family, such as a licensed home or center, or a friend or family member.

Families with children birth through 12 years old may be eligible if you meet income requirements and have a qualifying need for child care. Your eligibility is based on your gross monthly income and is adjusted for your family size.

Income Requirements:

<u>Family Size</u>	<u>Maximum Gross Monthly Income</u>
1-2	\$6,008
3	\$6,842
4	\$7,941
5	\$9,211

Qualifying Needs:

- working or attending school
- seeking employment
- experiencing homelessness
- incapacitated
- the child is deemed at risk of abuse or neglect by a legally qualified professional and/or is receiving Child Protective Services (requires referral)
