



To All NDR Nationals Families, Volunteers, Staff, and Guests,

Everything is still a "go" for Nationals 2021 in Indianapolis, IN. We have been made aware of a recent outbreak of COVID following an All-American rally race this past weekend. We managed to run a great event last year during the pandemic before vaccines were available. We plan on providing the same quality racing in an environment that is as safe as possible for our racing families and all the workers helping to make this event possible. The City of Indianapolis, Marion County, and the State of Indiana do not currently have any restrictions on outdoor events like ours. However, we did file the same COVID protocols as last year with our permits in case any mandates would be issued. We will follow guidelines and requirements set forth by the city, county, and state.

As we identified in your registration materials, we cannot guarantee that COVID will not be present. Coming to this event will have inherent risks. The virus can be spread without exhibiting symptoms or known exposure. For this reason, we will implement precautions below.

For Nationals, we will be utilizing a similar approach this year as we did last year in an effort to minimize the chance of COVID spread at the event. We will continue to have the following items present for your health and safety:

- Hand sanitizer
- Washing station
- Spare masks for anyone needing a replacement
- Spray sanitizer
- Sanitizer wipes
- Golf Carts for added transportation of drivers to top of hill

We will require that masks be worn within any of the high contact/utilized areas which include:

- Registration/Chart Tent
- Impound/Wheel Tent
- Inspection Tent
- Scaling Pavilion
- Transportation vehicles
- Starting pavilion staging area

These same areas should also be limited to the driver and their handler to help reduce contact and allow for smooth operations of those areas.

Hand sanitizer will be utilized in the wheel area for the wheel draw and encouraged to use before pulling your assigned wheels. Hand sanitizer will also be available top-side for use before/after wheel swap.

Drivers are not required to wear masks in cars. Masks can be pulled down or removed when loading. Outside of the aforementioned areas, you may choose whether or not you want to utilize a mask. We ask that everyone be considerate and respectful of others' decision to wear masks or not.

If you have any symptoms of COVID, we ask that you refrain from attending or that you receive a COVID test to confirm. In addition, if you have been exposed to the COVID virus within 14 days of our event, we encourage you to get tested to confirm you are COVID-free prior to coming.

If there is anyone that cannot attend due to contracting or being exposed to COVID within the 14 days prior to our event, please contact us and we will work out an appropriate refund of fees. The safety of everyone is a top concern of ours.
