## Thursday, September 2nd, 2021:

10:00 AM - Dusk

- The ISBD has offered to set up the track including the elapsed timer for any who wish to perform their own tests at the track
- NDR Wheel Bank is NOT expected to be available
- Trailers will be available to bring cars to top, but those practicing may need to assist with tow vehicles or driving.

## Friday, September 3rd, 2021:

10:00 AM - 8:00 PM Registration, Inspections, Scales, Photo, Practice Runs

### Notes:

- Track is restricted to **registered** and **inspected** cars for up to 4 practice runs per driver/event. For those who want a chance for more runs down the hill, please join us for the Indy NDR Rally, Aug 7th & 8th
- Elapsed Timer will be available
- Track will be lit up with portable lights to allow for Practice after sunset
- Anyone in town that can complete Check In Friday will help alleviate congestion
- No practice runs available after Friday - Track is reserved for racers only starting Saturday morning
- Legacy cars must be inspected on Friday in order to be ready to race Saturday morning.

8:00 PM - 10:00 PM - Track will remain open for practice runs under the lights, but you must be through inspections to participate in this practice timeframe.

All cars that complete there inspections are to be impounded in the large tent after completing:

- Optional Practice Runs
- Driver/Car Photo

8:00 PM - 9:00 PM - Heat Draws – Publicly conducted in Pavilion at bottom of hill

- Inspections of any division car will be available from the start of inspections. However, if you don't have any drivers in the Stock or Super Stock divisions, we expect it will be a lot less congested as the day proceeds and those cars are already on the hill racing

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## Stock and Super Stock Qualifier

- We will be racing the winners bracket of a Double Elimination race up to the top 4 drivers who will advance to Monday's Championships.
- Once a driver loses a heat, they will be moved over to the Consolation bracket and resume racing on Sunday morning. NDR Wheels should be returned and the car placed into the impound tent.

## Championship Heat Drawings - Stock, Super Stock, and Masters

- Championship races are complete 12 Car Double Elimination races, all drivers start out reset to no losses
- The 8 drivers from the Consolation Bracket of the Qualifiers get random drawn into the First Round of a 12 Car Double Elimination Chart (Heats 1 - 4)
- Top 4 from Winners side of Qualifiers get random drawn into Second Round of 12 Car Double Elimination Chart (Heats 5 - 6)
- No adjustments are being made for sibling relationships, whatever is drawn is where drivers will be placed

### Wilber Shaw Soap Box Derby Hill

Address: 2200 W 30th St, Indianapolis, IN 46222

Enter facility from N White River Parkway W Dr

Vehicles will not be permitted into the main track area starting on Saturday. Blockades will be placed to the east of the return vehicle loop. Follow any signs for car drop off. Parking will be available in the grass to the north and east of the Pit Tent in the grass. Golf course is no longer in operation. Cars may park in any of the mowed areas of the golf course.

Check-In along with Inspection and repair tents will be at the south side of the pit area, but not right next to the Impound Tent this year. When facing the impound tent from the south side, we will be entering it on the right with a return wheel area and exiting it on the left after obtaining wheels from the wheel bank. We expect to have a new path from the south side of the tent to the pavilion.

Large tent will be for impoundment of cars after inspection and the Wheel bank. The impound tent is a restricted area. Only the car handler and driver should enter the tent to return the car or retrieve the car when called upon. Any other access should be authorized by an official before entry. Please enter the tent through the main doors, not sides or rear.

Other areas that are also restricted to Driver and Car Handler only include:

- Inspection/Repair Tents
- Scales
- Starting Area

Bridge and Timer areas are for Authorized Personnel Only
