High Point Program Rules (Approved 1/6/24)

1. In addition to points received above, one additional point will be awarded for each horse defeated in the class.
2. TWH classes must be held on all days of multi-day shows for double points to be awarded. Out of state, multi-day shows with TWH classes only on one day of competition will be awarded single points only.
3. Shows must employ a USDA recognized HIO or HPI in accordance with the HPA for affiliation. Official copies of the show results must be sent within 30 days post-show to the HP Coordinator for SCWHA. These sheets will remain property of SCWHA.
4. Owner, Trainer, and Exhibitor must be members of SCWHA for point accrual to begin.
5. Date of paid membership will determine when points begin to accumulate.
6. If a horse is sold by a member of SCWHA to a non-member, the new owner must join within 30 days of the sale date for point accrual to continue.
7. Any class that is added or changed after the official class sheet has been posted will not count toward points unless show management has given the association at least 30 days notice.
8. Horses judged only once in any SCWHA affiliated show will count toward high points.
9. Once a show has started, and must be canceled for any reason, the classes already placed will be awarded high points.

10. All shows wishing to participate in the SCWHA High Point Program must be in good standing with the High Point Program. Shows must pay an affiliation fee, plus a completed affiliation application at least 30 days prior to the scheduled show date for board approval. There shall be no approval for shows occurring on already scheduled SCWHA dates, without prior board approval.
11. Trainers will accumulate points in all classes; flat and performance
12. The SCWHA BOD offers a “Start-Up” grant to all in-state, newly formed horse shows that offer classes within our recognized breeds.
13. The SCWHA will count as a quadruple-point horse show. The above tables shall be used in determining high point awards.
