State of the Association

As we strive for more transparency, the board is proud to share with you a positive, mid-year review of our membership and finances to date.

Financial Overview

As of July 1, the Association has brought in just under **\$30,000** in total income, with a wide range of contributions from our spring events, membership dues, sponsorships, and fundraising efforts.

Operating expenses to date total approximately **\$21,500**, covering our spring show, banquet, insurance, marketing, and other association functions.

We are currently operating with a net income of just over **\$8,000**, giving us a positive cushion to move into the second half of the year. This is a positive increase from our financial position in July 2024.

Membership Growth

We're proud to announce a 25% increase in membership over this time last year, currently at 148 members. This is a testament to the growth in engagement that we have seen at SC-affiliated events over the year.

Show Season Recap

The 2025 show season is off to a great start, with successful events already completed in Sumter, Columbia, and Florence. We've started the year with 16 shows to our High Point program, and we've seen strong membership support at those events thus far. There are two in-state shows left on the calendar (Palmetto Saddle and SC Championships), and 5 more opportunities in Waynesville, Bland, Winfield, Asheville, and White Pine.

The board is continuing to strive toward further stability for the future of the association. Cutting costs and increasing revenue have been two major contributors to this success.
