Prerequisites (if any): Students should roughly understand how to count coins (if not, no problem, we can provide assistance and discuss coin values) and basic working knowledge of adding and subtracting numbers. Also, should be able to display good sportsmanship and working with others as this class will involve lots of learning of money topics through game play.

Class Description: In this financial literacy class, we will introduce topics of budgeting, savings, making change, and spending wisely through games and short simulation exercises and a budgeting activity. The games that the students will rotate between weekly are based on the topics we will cover at the beginning of each class. The games are as follows: Money Bags, Managing My Allowance, Pay Day, Sub Shop, and Big Money.

Week 2: Let's Talk Managing Money (Cash, Checks, Debits, and Credits)!

Week 3: Let's Talk about Earning Money!

And play a Game!

Week 4: Let's Pay The Bills (Bill Paying Skills Activity)

Week 5: Let's Plan a Party (Kids will plan a class party using a strict budget!)

Week 6: Let's Plan a Party Review and Party! (Play games and enjoy their party)

Week 7: Let's Talk Savings! What do we save for and why?

Week 8: Let's Talk Entrepreneurship!

Week 9: Hey, you, Consumer! (How finances affect our daily decisions!)



Week 10: Introduce the concept of Assets and Liabilities!
