My goal is to make tennis more accessible and affordable, creating a pool of skilled tennis players in Temple City.

Our programs are designed to ensure kids have fun, make new friends, and develop a passion for tennis. Tennis teaches valuable life skills such as problem-solving, independence, accountability, resilience, and how to overcome failures. Thus, we are not only developing good tennis players but also capable young citizens.
