# Discussion of my Artist journey and my "I DO Know Jack!" Series.

Kenneth Hershenson is a self taught acrylic painter whose artistic approach is rooted in the twin disciplines of realism and illustration. Architectural design and illustration are the basis of much of his professional life, which included serving as an architectural designer with Disneyland in California and designing Japan stores for Starbucks while living in Seattle.

He has participated in many juried art shows and has won a number of awards in watercolor, drawing and painting including several national awards. He creates images that provide the viewer with a sense of joy, humor and a relief from the day-to-day stresses of 21st century life. Currently, he is exploring reflections in chrome in his award-winning "I DO Know Jack!" series of hyperealistic acrylic paintings. Toy chrome jacks are placed in unexpected settings and scales and each painting is titled with a play on words. He is fascinated with the concept of

connecting the viewer to a world that exists outside of the edges of the painting through reflective surfaces. These paintings have proven to engage people of all ages.

His paintings have been published in numerous nationally distributed art books including five issues of AcrylicWorks: The Best of Acrylic Painting series 2015-2018 and 2023 plus six issues of the annual Richeson75 Still Life and Floral Exhibit, 2016-2020 and 2023. His painting Jack of Clubs received an Award of Excellence from the National Oil & Acrylic Painters' Society and Pepper Jack Cheese was selected for the 2023 International Guild of Realism Fall Salon show. Ken is a member of the International Guild of Realism and the National Oil & Acrylic Painters' Society, and taught painting at Atelier School of Art in Royal Oak, MI.


