Reflections

Carol Cook Reid's paintings are inspired by and reflect nature. During difficult times she finds comfort in natural environments - in outdoor views from windows and through doorways, along walkways and roadsides, in natural preserves, city parks, and formal gardens – wherever she experiences the interrelated elements of flora, earth and sky. Memories of these experiences spark her creativity.

Reid's compositions are responses to visual and emotional encounters with nature. A blank canvas is like an empty stage, ready to receive dancers, actors, and backdrops. She is the choreographer. Sharing one space, all design elements in a composition are interdependent. A patch of sky is defined by the surrounding land; and the land, by intersecting flora. Their shared contours define their individuality as well as their relationships to each other. Arranging the elements to create a balance in two dimensions is an exciting challenge. The entire creative process between remembering, composing and completing her reflections with paint on canvas brings her joy and inner peace.

Reid studied art and education at Michigan State University, and then taught art to elementary school students. Upon retiring, she developed her creative expression. She completed a master's degree in painting at Wayne State University at the age of seventy. Her work has been exhibited in galleries throughout Michigan, and received numerous awards.
