"I wanted to let you know my mom Donna Jurovcik passed away back on January 19th of this year. My mom and I fought a two year battle with bladder cancer. She was President of the SOAA at one point in time. I can remember her doing shows at the American Center in Southfield, where I also helped her as a kid growing up. She loved the SOAA and she made many friends there through the years and those relationships lasted for years and years. My mom was very good friends with Jo Chiapelli and Noreen Delbon-Fritz (also both deceased), who were also both members of the SOAA. My mom is now buried next to my dad at Holy Sepulchre Cemetery in Southfield. I have included several of her works that are displayed here in our home. My mom loved painting watercolors and oils of nature, seascapes and animals. She was able to capture moments of such in a very special way. 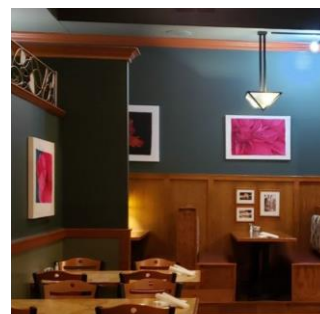
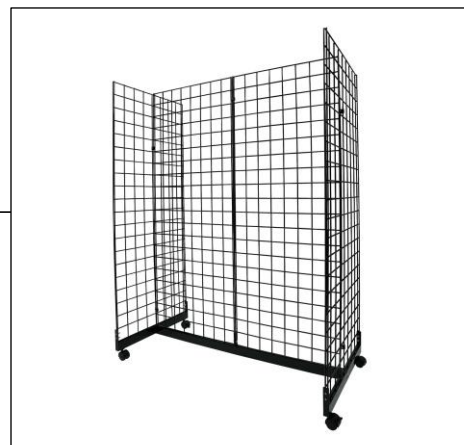
