Susan Donnellon has been creating art for most of her life, working across a wide range of media including pencil, charcoal, oil, watercolor, colored pencil, paper quilling, and acrylics—her preferred medium.

In 1994, she began painting commissioned pet portraits, which has since grown into a thriving side business through word of mouth. Her work is deeply personal, and she values the emotional connections her paintings create for others. In addition to portraiture, Susan is well known for her bird paintings and ornaments, earning her the affectionate nickname "The Bird Lady." Her hand-painted bird ornaments are available at Wild Birds Unlimited in Royal Oak.

Most recently, Susan has expanded her practice into needle felting, a process that uses wool roving and barbed needles to create both 2-D and 3-D works of art.

#### **ENTRY LIMITS**

- Number of entries may be adjusted due to the number of entrants participating. If a change is necessary, you will be notified.
  - Hanging Art: 5 pieces
  - 3D Art: 10 small pieces or 5 large
  - Note Cards: No limit, but we share two racks
  - Bin Art: 10 pieces

#### ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

#### Labels

- You will need two labels for hanging pieces:
  - One label will be placed on the back of the piece
  - One label will be placed next to your art on display
  - You will need one label for each bin item or 3D piece
  - Note Cards should have a label on each card with artist, title & price.
  - Frames must be scratch free, with no chips or cracked glass.
  - Use only braided wire to hang art. Wire should not be too taut. Work not meeting standards will not be hung. The backs of all hung artwork should look neat. Nails should not show, Dust covers, foam core or matt board should be used when needed to tidy up backs. 9 of 14

- All bin and card items must be covered with plastic with name and price on the back. Unframed, matted originals & prints will be accepted for the bins. Note Cards will be on a card rack. Giclee prints should be labeled as such (i.e. Reproduction of....)
  - No wet painting will be allowed. No exceptions!
  - All work must be original i.e. not from copy-righted sources. No exceptions!
  - Artwork must be tasteful. The exhibit committee has the discretion to reject any artwork that is considered to be inappropriate for this venue.

We want to be proud of this exhibit - Please do your best to help out and cooperate with our exhibit staff.
