Membership Terms & Conditions

These Membership Terms & Conditions apply to memberships provided by Brennan's Gym and The Barn ABC.

By purchasing, registering for or using a membership, you agree to these Terms & Conditions and any applicable Club policies, including The Barn ABC Club Code of Conduct, safeguarding requirements and applicable England Boxing rules and regulations. Where the member is under 18, their membership must be agreed to by a parent or legal guardian.

1. Membership Options

Full Membership: £60 per month

Includes:

- Gym access
- Access to included boxing and circuit classes

Gym Only Membership: £35 per month

Includes:

- Gym access

Gym Full + Reformer: £130 per month

Includes:

- Gym access
- Access to included boxing and circuit classes
- 4 Reformer Pilates sessions per calendar month

Gym Only + Reformer: £100 per month

Includes:

- Gym access
- 4 Reformer Pilates sessions per calendar month

Membership prices and inclusions may be reviewed periodically. Members will be given reasonable notice of any changes affecting their membership.

Individual classes, specialist sessions, courses, events, personal training or other services are not automatically included in a membership unless specifically stated.

2. Concessionary Membership

The Barn ABC believes that financial circumstances should not prevent somebody from participating in boxing.

Where the cost of membership would create a financial barrier to participation at The Barn ABC, an adult or the parent/carer of a junior participant may apply for Concessionary Membership at no cost.

Applications are confidential and considered individually through our Concessionary Membership Application process.

Concessionary Membership is intended to provide access to the sporting activities of The Barn ABC. It does not automatically include additional paid services such as Circuits, Reformer Pilates, Gym Access or other separately charged services unless specifically agreed.

Concessionary members remain subject to the same applicable Club Code of Conduct, safeguarding requirements, policies and participation standards as other members.

3. Membership Payments

Membership fees are payable monthly on the 1st of each Month.

Our preferred payment method is Direct Debit.

Memberships operate on a calendar-month basis and regular membership payments cover the relevant calendar month.

Members are responsible for ensuring their payment details remain valid and that sufficient funds are available for membership payments.

Where a payment fails or remains outstanding, access to the gym, classes or other membership services may be temporarily suspended until payment has been resolved.

4. Joining Part-Way Through a Month

Where a membership begins part-way through a calendar month, the initial membership payment will be calculated using a standard 30-day pro-rata calculation.

The calculation is:

Monthly Membership Fee ÷ 30 × Number of Membership Days Remaining

Where the Direct Debit collection for the following month has already been arranged, or there is insufficient time to add the new member to that collection, the initial payment may include:

The pro-rata amount for the current month + the following month's full membership fee.

Regular monthly Direct Debit payments will then begin from the next available collection.

The initial payment amount and the membership period it covers will be confirmed when the membership is set up.

5. Cancelling Your Membership

Unless otherwise specifically agreed, memberships do not have a fixed minimum term.

If you wish to cancel your membership, you are responsible for cancelling your Direct Debit instruction directly with your bank.

Cancelling the Direct Debit will be treated as notice that you wish to cancel your membership.

Membership will remain active until the end of the membership period that has already been paid for.

Membership payments already collected are non-refundable except where required by law or where otherwise agreed by us.

Members should cancel their Direct Debit sufficiently in advance of the next scheduled payment to prevent a further payment being collected.

6. Reformer Memberships

Memberships which include Reformer Pilates provide 4 Reformer sessions per calendar month.

Reformer sessions must be booked through the applicable booking system and remain subject to availability.

The 4 included sessions are intended for use within the relevant calendar month and do not roll over into subsequent months.

Unused sessions cannot ordinarily be exchanged for cash, refunded or transferred to another person.

Additional Reformer sessions may be purchased separately at the applicable member rate.

Members remain responsible for booking their sessions. Membership does not guarantee availability for a particular class, instructor, day or time.

Applicable cancellation and no-show rules continue to apply to Reformer sessions booked as part of a membership.

7. Classes & Bookings

Where classes are included within a membership, members are responsible for booking their place where booking is required.

Classes are subject to availability and membership does not guarantee a place in a particular class, or with a particular coach, on a particular day or time.

We operate a 24-hour cancellation policy for all booked classes and sessions.

Cancellations made more than 24 hours before the scheduled start time may be cancelled or rescheduled in accordance with the applicable booking arrangements.

Where a class or session is cancelled within 24 hours of the scheduled start time, or the member does not attend their booking, the session will not be refunded, credited or rescheduled.

For memberships which include a limited number of sessions, including Reformer memberships, a late cancellation or non-attendance will be treated as a used session and deducted from the member's monthly allocation.

Members are asked to cancel bookings they are unable to attend as early as possible so that the space can be offered to another member.

Classes and timetables may occasionally change due to coach availability, competitions, holidays, maintenance, exceptional circumstances or other operational requirements. Where we cancel a class or session, the member will not lose that session from any limited monthly allocation.

8. Gym Access

Gym access is available during the access hours applicable to the member's membership.

Current independent gym access hours are 4:00am-11:00pm, subject to any restrictions communicated by Brennan's Gym.

Members using the gym independently are responsible for:

- Checking in as required.
- Using equipment safely and appropriately.
- Following gym rules and safety instructions.
- Returning keys or other access equipment to the designated location (key box) where applicable.
- Ensuring the premises are appropriately secured when they are the last person to leave.
- Reporting damaged or unsafe equipment.
- Respecting other members and neighbouring premises.
- Not allowing unauthorised people to enter or use the gym.

Access arrangements, codes, keys or other security information must not be shared with another person.

Membership is personal to the member and cannot be shared or transferred.

9. Guests

Guests may only use the gym or participate in activities where permitted and in accordance with the applicable guest arrangements.

Members are responsible for ensuring that their guest follows the gym rules and applicable standards of conduct.

Guest access cannot be transferred, accumulated or exchanged for cash unless specifically stated.

10. Safe Participation

Members are responsible for participating within their own abilities and for informing an appropriate coach or member of staff of information that may reasonably affect their ability to participate safely.

Members must follow reasonable safety instructions and use equipment appropriately.

Where a coach or member of staff reasonably believes that somebody cannot participate safely, participation may be modified, restricted or stopped.

Members must not undertake sparring, contact boxing or other activities requiring coaching supervision without appropriate permission and supervision from a Barn L2 England Boxing Coach.

11. Alcohol, Drugs, Smoking & Vaping

Members must not attend training, classes or other activities while under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs.

Alcohol and illegal drugs must not be consumed or used on the premises.

The possession, supply or distribution of illegal drugs on the premises is prohibited.

Smoking and vaping are not permitted inside or around the gym.

Anyone reasonably believed to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or otherwise not in a suitable condition to participate safely, may be refused entry or asked to leave.

The supply of alcohol, tobacco, vapes or illegal substances to junior participants is strictly prohibited.

12. Behaviour & Code of Conduct

Everyone using Brennan's Gym or participating in activities delivered by The Barn ABC is expected to behave respectfully and contribute positively to the environment.

Members must treat coaches, volunteers, other members, boxers, parents, visitors and officials appropriately.

Bullying, harassment, discrimination, intimidation, threatening behaviour, violence or abuse will not be accepted.

Members participating in boxing activities are subject to the The Barn ABC Club Code of Conduct and applicable England Boxing rules and regulations.

The Barn's existing Complaints Policy establishes the club's values of manners, integrity, respect and discipline and applies those expectations to coaches, boxers, members, volunteers, parents and carers.

13. Junior Members & Parents/Carers

Parents and carers registering a junior member agree to support their child in following the Club Code of Conduct and applicable safety and safeguarding requirements.

Parents/carers are also expected to behave in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Club Code of Conduct when attending or communicating with the Club.

Parents/carers should provide information reasonably necessary for coaches to understand and safely support their child's participation.

Where a coach determines that a junior member cannot safely continue a session or activity, the parent/carer may be contacted and required to collect them.

14. Additional Needs & Reasonable Adjustments

We aim to provide an inclusive environment and recognise that members may have different abilities, disabilities, additional needs, communication needs and individual circumstances.

We encourage members and parents/carers to make us aware of relevant information that may help us safely support participation.

Where appropriate, we will consider reasonable adjustments to support participation.

Individual needs and reasonable adjustments will be considered alongside the safety, welfare and reasonable participation of the individual and others using the Club.

Where participation cannot be safely or reasonably supported in a particular activity or environment, we may discuss alternative arrangements or additional support and, where necessary, restrict, pause or withdraw participation.

Any such decision will be considered on the individual circumstances and will not be made simply because somebody has a disability, diagnosis or additional need.

15. Suspension or Withdrawal of Membership

Membership and participation are conditional upon members respecting these Terms & Conditions, applicable Club policies and standards of behaviour.

Where appropriate, minor concerns may initially be addressed informally. Serious or repeated breaches may result in restrictions being placed upon participation, suspension of access or withdrawal of membership.

There is no requirement for every matter to progress through a series of warnings where there is serious misconduct or an immediate concern regarding safety or welfare.

Membership or participation may also be restricted, paused or withdrawn where we reasonably believe that continuing to participate is not in the best interests of the member's physical or emotional wellbeing, even where there has been no misconduct or breach of Club rules.

Where appropriate, we will discuss our concerns with the member and, for junior members, their parent or carer, and consider whether reasonable adjustments, alternative activities or a period away from participation may be appropriate.

However, the welfare of the individual will take priority over continued participation. Where we reasonably believe that an activity or the Club environment is causing, contributing to or significantly worsening distress, unsafe behaviour or risk of harm, we may stop or withdraw participation.

Where necessary to protect the individual or others, participation or access may be suspended immediately while the situation is considered.

Any decision will be based on the individual circumstances and, where applicable, made in accordance with our safeguarding responsibilities, Club policies and England Boxing requirements.

16. Complaints & Concerns

We welcome appropriate feedback and want concerns to be raised through the correct channels.

Complaints relating to The Barn ABC should be raised in accordance with The Barn ABC Complaints Policy.

The current Complaints Policy provides for informal resolution where appropriate and formal complaints to be submitted in writing to hello@brennanboxing.com.

Raising a genuine complaint, concern or safeguarding matter will not in itself disadvantage a member. Everyone remains expected to communicate respectfully while raising or responding to a concern.

17. Personal Belongings

Members are responsible for their own belongings while using the premises.

Brennan's Gym and The Barn ABC cannot accept responsibility for loss, theft or damage to personal belongings except where responsibility cannot lawfully be excluded.

Members should not leave valuable items unattended.

18. Equipment & Facilities

Members must use equipment appropriately and for its intended purpose.

Any damage, defect or safety concern should be reported as soon as reasonably possible.

Deliberate or reckless damage to equipment, facilities or property may result in the member being responsible for reasonable repair or replacement costs and may result in suspension or withdrawal of membership.

19. Changes, Closures & Availability

From time to time it may be necessary to change opening hours, timetables, access arrangements or the availability of particular facilities or services.

This may include changes required because of maintenance, competitions, coach availability, holidays, emergencies, safety concerns or circumstances outside our reasonable control.

We will provide members with reasonable notice wherever practicable.

Short-term changes to timetables, opening hours or availability do not automatically entitle a member to a refund.

Nothing within these Terms & Conditions affects a member's statutory rights.

20. Changes to Membership Terms

These Terms & Conditions may be reviewed and updated periodically to reflect changes to membership arrangements, facilities, Club policies, regulatory requirements or the operation of Brennan's Gym and The Barn ABC.

Where a change materially affects an existing member's membership, reasonable notice will be provided.

The current version of the Membership Terms & Conditions will be made available to members.

21. Acceptance

By purchasing, registering for or continuing to use a membership, the member confirms that they have read and agree to these Membership Terms & Conditions.

Where the membership includes participation in The Barn ABC, the member also agrees to comply with the The Barn ABC Club Code of Conduct, applicable safeguarding policies and England Boxing rules and regulations.

Where the member is under 18, their parent or legal guardian accepts these Terms & Conditions on their behalf and agrees to comply with the provisions that apply to parents and carers.
