There are few existing venues for the publication of this kind of article, and creating a space for them was one of our goals in creating the Journal. If you are interested in submitting this type of article, we invite you to send an abstract describing your proposed topic.

Third, JLPS publishes book reviews, preferably reviewing books written by our members. If you have a book you would like to review or would like to have one of your publications reviewed, please contact us to pursue this option. Additionally, we are looking for willing reviewers so let us know if you would like to be added to the pool of potential reviewers.

Please submit your paper as a Word document with personal identifiers removed for consideration in volume 10. The Journal publishes its volumes from annual meeting to annual meeting. Volume 10 therefore runs from the Sydney Annual Meeting in June 2025 to the Tulane Annual Meeting in June 2026.
