### **Find the Odd One Out Answers**

At the Bus Stop: D - Playing in the street. Better choice: stay on the sidewalk and talk quietly.

On the Bus: D - Yelling across the bus. Better choice: use a polite inside voice and greet Mr. Terry.

In the Cafeteria: D - Yelling across the cafeteria. Better choice: talk politely with people close by and clean up.

In Art Class: D - Grabbing supplies. Better choice: ask, "Please pass the crayon," and say "Thank you."
