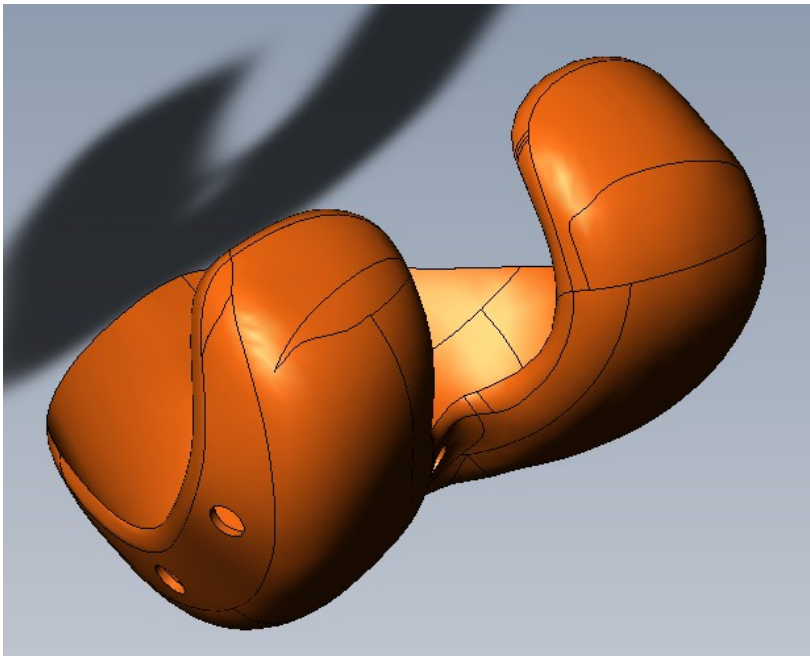


iKnee

POLYMERIC JOINT CAP



iOrthopedics, Inc. (iOI) strives to provide minimally invasive comfort care (MIS) with non-significant risk (NSR) using iKnees. These polymer femoral resurfacing caps, fill the arthritic knee treatment gap between pills and prostheses. When patients exhaust conservative care, as meds (topical/oral/injected), PT, and braces they may be urged to undergo joint resection and replacement with metal and hard PE prosthetics, in use for >70 years. Now 21st century safe PU materials pad knee femoral cartilage, cushioning stance and gait. Custom made for Goodness of Fit, iKnees are delivered via outpatient arthroscopically-aided techniques, along with pharmacologics and autologous chondrocytes to provide patients' speedy return to work or sport, restoring joints.

iKnees are finally available for trials in patients with "reasonable expectations". As temporary spacers covering distal femurs, comfortable gliding of the femur against tibial and patellar surfaces promotes independence in ADL. Innovations among materials and design provide the Right To Try mobilizing faster, cheaper, better via outpatient iKnee solutions. Major collaboration and testing have resulted in patents, prototypes, and IRB IDE permission to start human use trials on 100 patients.
