



OUTLAW ARENA RULES AND POLICIES

The Outlaw Arena is open and available for use and enjoyment for all members of the community. The facility is maintained and managed by employees of the Outlaw Arena. Facility use is restricted to individuals and/or groups who have paid appropriate fees and have agreed to follow and abide by the Outlaw Arena Rules and Policies.

MISSION STATEMENT

At The Outlaw Arena, our mission is to celebrate Arizona's rich Western heritage while creating a dynamic space that brings our community together. From exciting rodeo events to versatile gatherings, we strive to be a premier destination for entertainment, family-friendly fun, and memorable experiences. As we continue to grow, we aim to host a variety of events, supporting local talent and providing a gathering place for celebrations of all kinds. Rooted in tradition and looking toward the future, The Outlaw Arena is dedicated to fostering a sense of pride and connection for our town and beyond.

OUTLAW ARENA USERS

Before any activity, all equestrians who wish to use the facilities have signed and completed a participant release for the current year.

FACILITY AND GROUNDS

Hours of Operation: Outlaw Arena is open for events as scheduled. Calendar will be posted on our website and facebook page.

Safety: Safety and security of people, animals and property is the number one priority at the Outlaw Arena. Any act of circumstance deemed unsafe by the Outlaw Arena representative must cease immediately upon notice.

Parking: Due caution must be given to horses and riders and other facility users. Park vehicles and trailers in a conservative, courteous manner so all participants can enjoy the facility. Do not park within 40 feet of the entrance to arena, or vendor area.

Pets: Dogs must be on a leash and under control at all times. No dogs are permitted to be tied to panels of arena or in vendor area.

Children: Children under the age of 18 years of age, whether mounted or on foot, must be supervised by a parent/legal guardian at all times.

Alcohol & Drugs: No alcoholic beverages are allowed without appropriate permit on file. No drugs are allowed.

Firearms: No firearms are allowed without appropriate permit on file.

Smoking: No smoking within 30 feet of the arena.

Electrical Hookups: Electrical hookups are not provided. Generators are available, and welcome to be brought for events.

Trash: All trash must be deposited in trashcans or dumpsters as provided.

HORSE AND RIDERS

"No Horse" Zone: Areas in the vicinity of the spectator bleachers, announcers booth, and the Snack Shack concession stand are off limits to horses at all times.

Horse Control: Horses must be tied or under hand control. Horses are prohibited from being tied to the arena panels at all times. No loose horses are allowed. Stallions must be under the control of an experienced adult. No juniors may handle stallions at any time. A junior is any person younger than 18 years of age. Tying to a trailer requires that an adult be in attendance at all times. **Only allow horses to walk into and out of the arena. Horses are to stay at walking speed only on the property when outside the arena.**

Scheduled Events: Events with completed reservations have priority over everyday use of the arenas. A calendar is provided on our website.

Arenas: Leave the arenas the way you found them, or better. Cleaning up after your horse is required. Use arena etiquette such as: left shoulder to left shoulder, slow on the inside and fast on the outside, announce your intentions, mount out of the way, don't stand still on the track/rail, keep a horse length between horses and in an emergency, dismount!

Facility Equipment: Renters are allowed responsible use of certain facility equipment (jumps, barrels, poles, cones, etc) for event and training purposes. Unless other arrangements have been made with the Outlaw Arena, all equipment must be returned to its original storage location after each use. All facility equipment must be treated with the proper level of care and respect, or future access to the equipment may be denied and fines assessed.

Riding Double: NO riding double on any horse or other animal is allowed on the grounds of the Outlaw Arena. Special exception for trick riders being coached or exhibiting while covered by insurance.

Riding Equipment: All junior riders (younger than 18 years) must wear approved helmets at all times when riding anywhere on the grounds, including the trail system. The only exception to this rule is during recognized, sanctioned and properly insured events with rules for attire that are different than those of the Outlaw Arena.

Vendors: Commercial vendors are welcome to sell products and services at the Outlaw Arena. Please contact the Outlaw Arena for the vendor policy and application form. All vendors are subject to and required to follow and enforce the "Rules and Policies" of the Outlaw Arena.

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

The Outlaw Arena facilities are for the use and enjoyment of its members and their families and guests. Users will be responsible for the conduct of their guests while at the facility. Designated Outlaw Arena or event management reserve the right to enforce the Rules and Policies explained herein, refuse admittance, or to direct any person to leave the facility if their conduct does not conform to the Outlaw Arena Rules and Policies or to good social conduct. Disregard for these rules by members/users/guests may result in an order to vacate the facility. Actions such as physical or verbal abuse of members/users/spectators or management, abuse of animals, intentional damage or destruction of the facility or member property, use of narcotics, alcohol and/or theft may result in immediate expulsion from the premises and law enforcement may be contacted. The Outlaw Arena reserves the right to refuse service to anyone at any time. Cruelty to, or the abuse of any horse or other animal by any person(s) on the grounds of The Outlaw Arena is strictly forbidden and may result in the loss of facility privileges.

All Outlaw Arena staff, and designated officials are empowered to enforce any and all of the Outlaw Arena's Rules and Policies. Failure to follow the rules, or to immediately come into compliance with the requirements once notified, may result in expulsion.
