MUSWELL HILL BOWLING CLUB BYE-LAWS

1. Use of the Green

- 1.1. Scheduled matches, as indicated on the annual Fixture List, have priority for the use of the green
- 1.2. Rinks not used in these matches are available for general play, subject to permission of the Captain/Competition organiser.
- 1.3. When no matches are scheduled. The green is available for general play.
- 1.4. Social events may make use of the green, subject to permission from the Committee.
- 1.5. Everyone using the green must wear flat-soled shoes, in order to protect the green.
- 1.6. Dogs and other animals are not allowed on the green.
- 1.7. In special cases the Committee may vary these rules.

2. Dress

- 2.1. For matches, the Fixture List will indicate whether "Whites" or "Greys" (colours of trousers and skirts) should be worn.
- 2.2. For external matches, club (polo) shirts should be worn.

3. Access to Club Premises

- 3.1. Apart from current members of the club, visitors are only allowed with the permission of the host member responsible and must be accompanied at all times.
- 3.2. For Open Days all visitors will be welcome. The dates for Open Days will be agreed by the Committee and shown on the Fixture List. Members present will keep an eye on visitors and report to a member of the Committee if any problems occur.
- 3.3. Any dogs or other animals coming to the club premises must be controlled by their owners; for example, dogs should be on a leash.
- 3.4. The Committee has the right to refuse access to the premises for any person (or animal) due to antisocial behaviour.
- 3.5. Keys will be allocated to Playing Members only at the absolute discretion of the Committee and in any event only after the completion of one year's Playing Membership.
